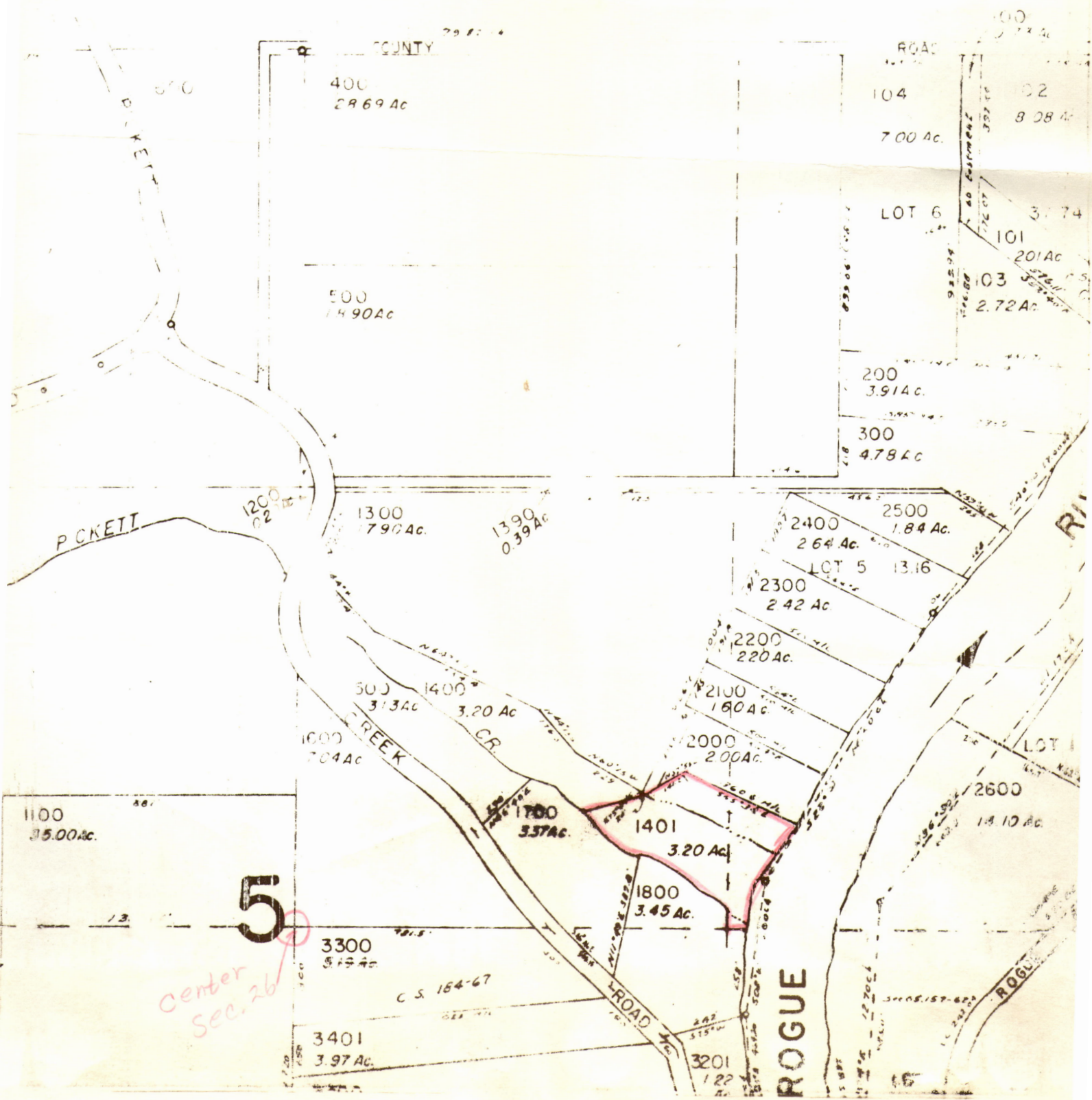

Dear Mr. Steimer:

From the record I cannot specifically locate the 13.0 acre right you refer to in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 26, Township 35 South, Range 7 West, W.M. I have some doubt that a valid right to this extent exists.

Certificate 16593 includes 9.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$. This is a vested right and the Rogue map does not clearly locate the ditch. I assume this land is shown on the inchoate map. When proof was submitted for permit 602, it contained a statement that instead of a pump, the delivery was made by the Dunn and English ditch about 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles upstream from the proposed pump point. The 9.0 acres under certificate 16593 and 13.0 acres under certificate 815 must be between the ditch and the creek. It is possible that despite the 1912 filing, Dunn and English submitted a claim for part of the same lands for the adjudication proceedings. It was not unusual for an individual to make application for a permit to make a record even though he claimed use prior to 1909. The proof of claim may shed some light on this.

Is there a ditch in existence for the irrigation of any part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$? If so, the adjoining owner to the west may claim the entire right. If you have inspected this area, perhaps you can furnish more information.

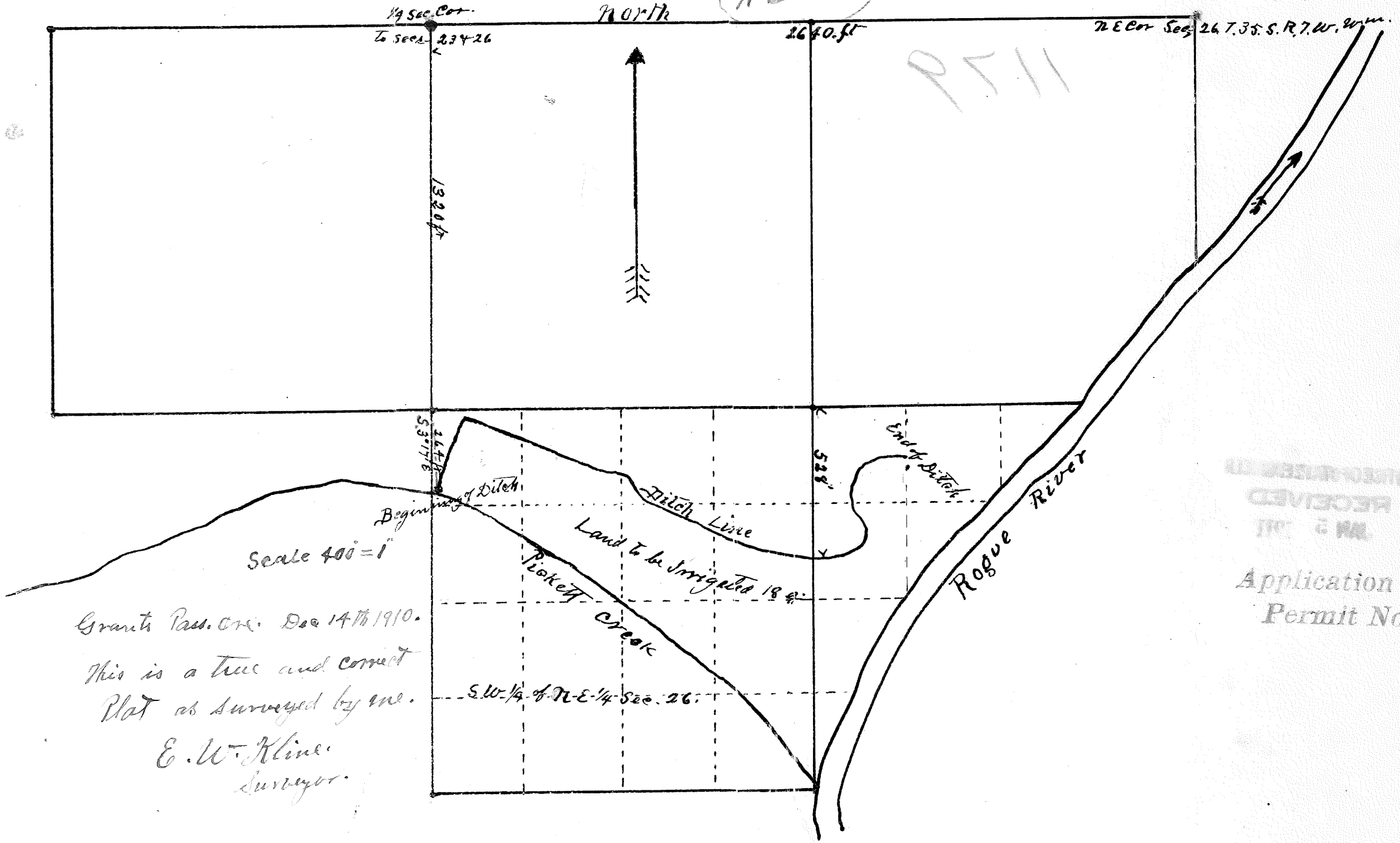
