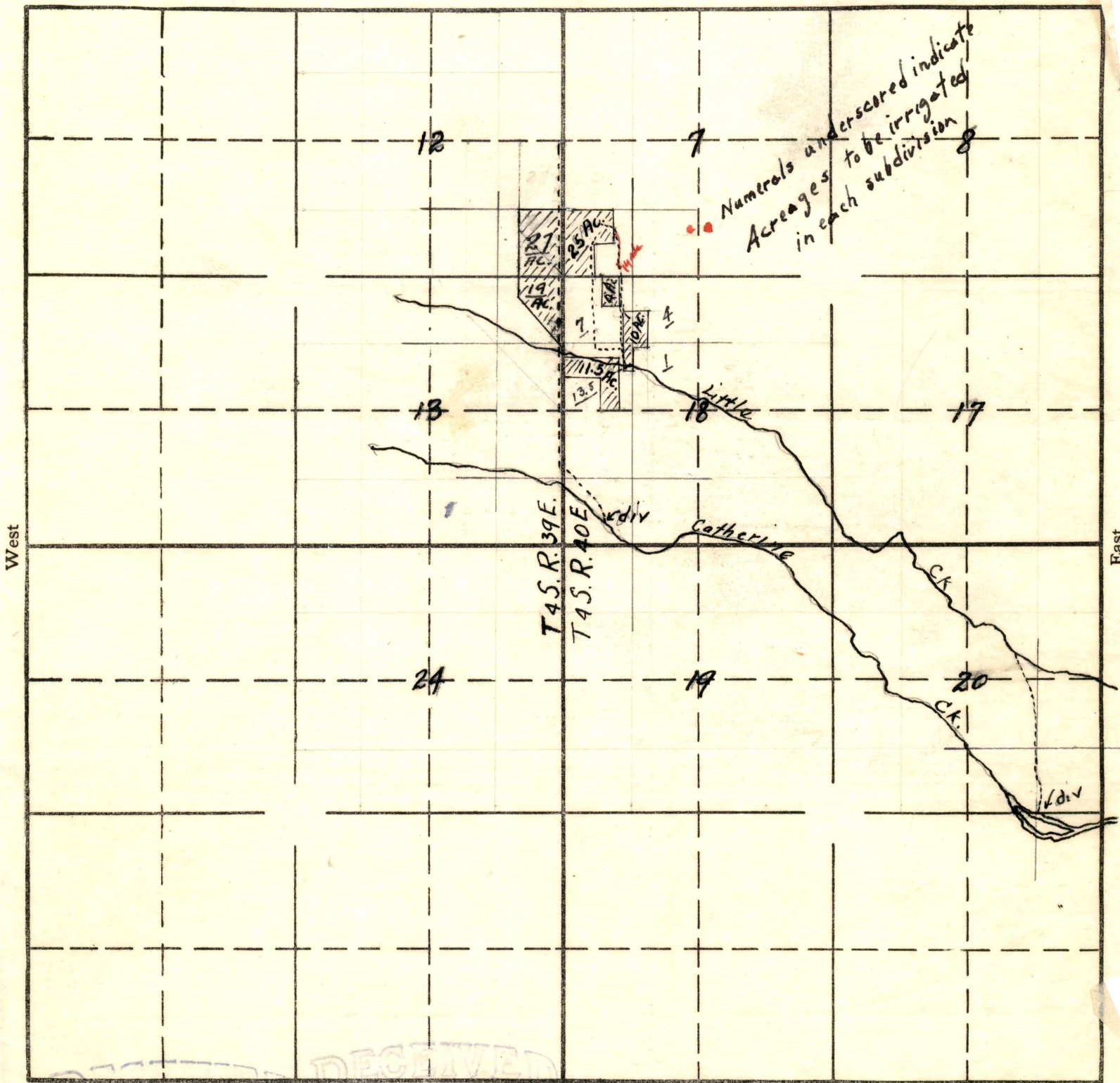

ABSTRACT OF CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT NO. 13497

J. B. Weaver of Union State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Engineer of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Catherine Creek a tributary of Grande Ronde River, for the purpose of Supplemental Irrigation under Permit No. 12500 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 15, 1936; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.21 cubic feet per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation .

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (#1) of Section 20, and #2 in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, both Township 4 South, Range 40 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

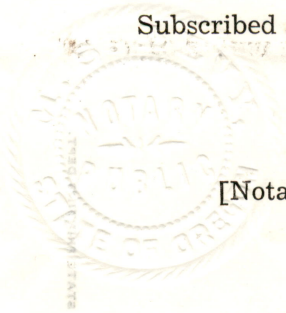

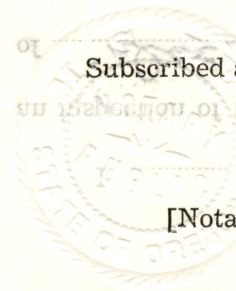

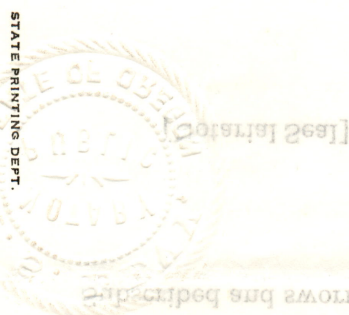

Dear Gordon:

This office is just in receipt of an application in the name of J. B. Weaver for a permit to appropriate 0.575 second-foot of water from Catherine Creek for the supplemental irrigation of 46 acres.

From the enclosed map, I believe that you probably have knowledge of this application, and since it appears to duplicate a part of Permit No. 12500 in the name of J. B. Weaver, it seems advisable to take the matter up with you before filing the application since I do not believe two permits can be issued covering water for the same lands from the same source in this instance since to do so would be to double the amount of water decreed by the court to these lands.

I am enclosing herewith a blue print of the map which accompanied Application No. 16714 which was approved by issuance of Permit No. 12500, and will await your advice as to Mr. Weaver's present application. Application No. 16714 contains a statement to the effect that all ditches are completed but does not state that water has been applied.

This acknowledges receipt of your application for permit to appropriate 1.21 second foot of water from Catherine Creek for irrigation, together with a remittance in the amount of \$5.00. Receipt No. 21060 is enclosed.

The application has been filed given No. 16714 and is being returned for correction and your signature and that of witnesses. The application indicates under item 8 that 25 acres will be irrigated in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 7 and 12 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 13, while the map indicates that these lands will be within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 7 and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 13 respectively.

Necessary correction should be made on the map or under item 8, and a balance of fees due in the amount of \$14.55 for recording for irrigation of 36.5 acres must be paid before the permit can be issued. The application has been endorsed so that in order to retain its priority it must be returned to this office within 30 days or on or before January 19.
