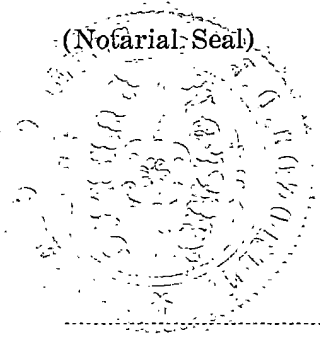



I note from the records of this office that you have not submitted final proof under your permit No. 51 which covers the use of 5 second feet of water from Rockaway Creek for a municipal supply for a municipal supply for Rockaway, Oregon, although final proof blanks were forwarded you for execution on Dec. 10, 1915. According to the terms of this permit construction work should have begun on or before July 23, 1910, be completed on or before July 23, 1912, and the water applied to the proposed use on or before July 23, 1915. If the terms of this permit have been complied with, we would be glad to have you submit the final proof in order that we may bring our records up to date by the issuance of the final water right certificate.

On the other hand, if you have abandoned this water right and do not intend to submit final proof, we would be glad to have you authorize the cancellation of the permit on the records of this office as this will eliminate the necessity of following the regular procedure for the cancellation of the same.


