CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the SNAKE RIVER, a tributary to the COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 99.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-33944. The date of priority is OCTOBER 25, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.318 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of 1/75.61 of one cfs, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
