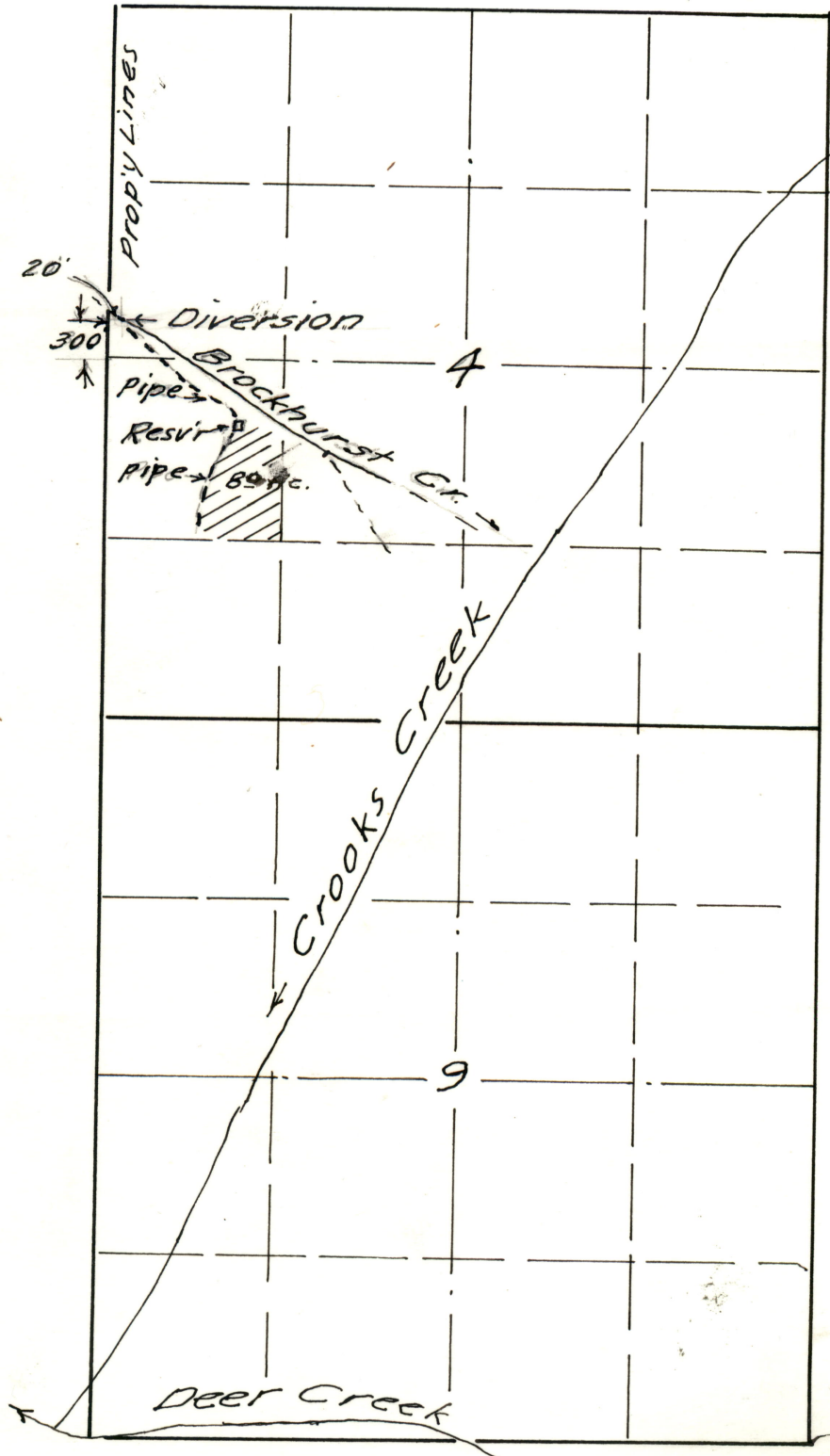

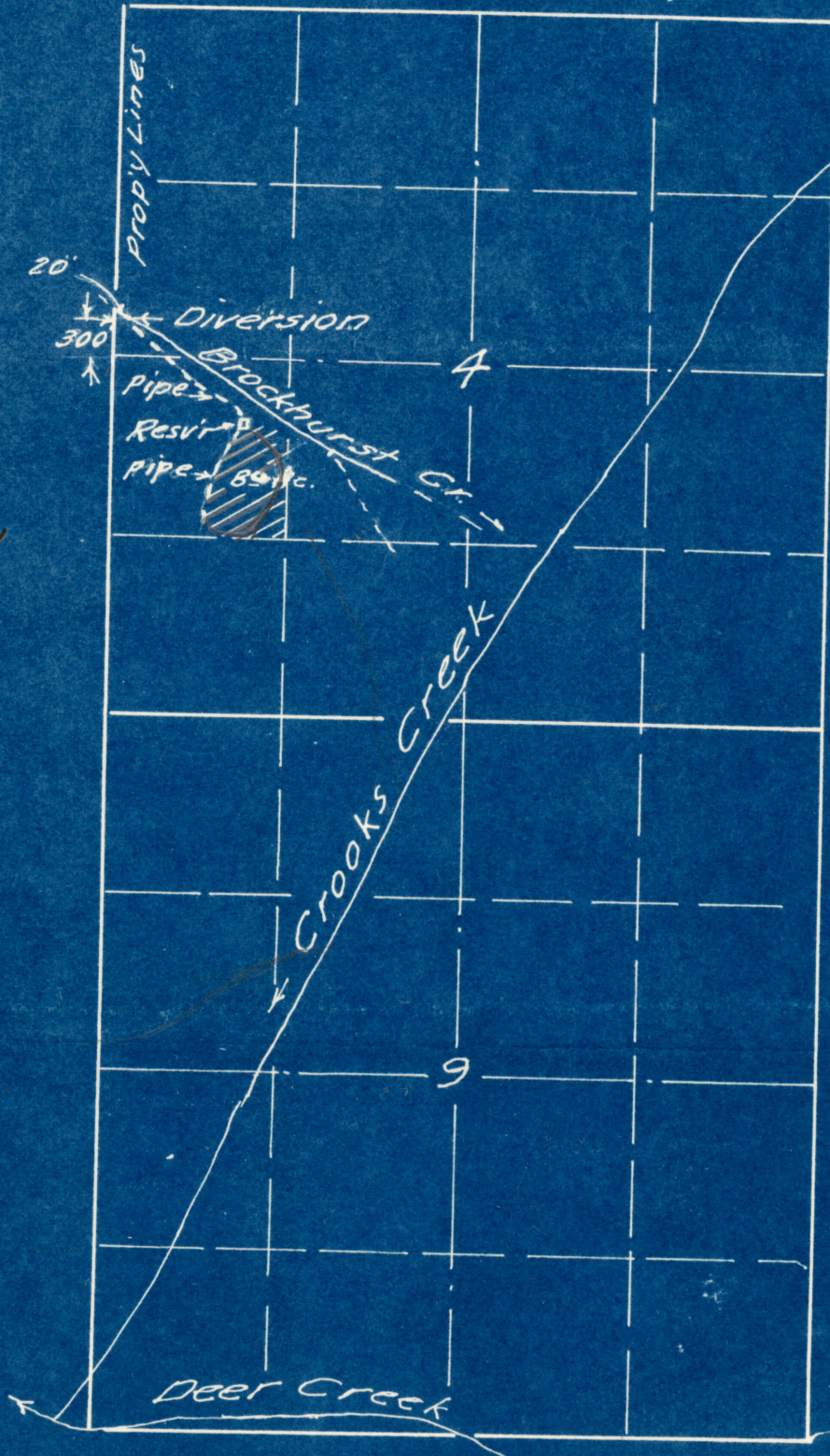


Dear Mr. Ramsey:
