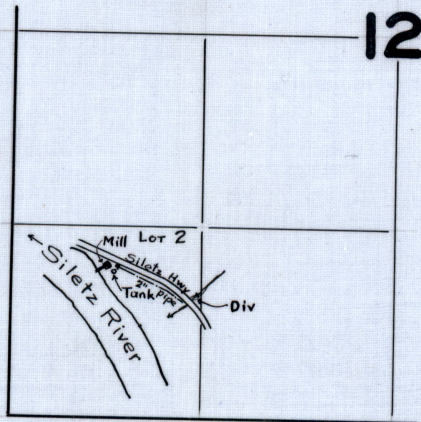

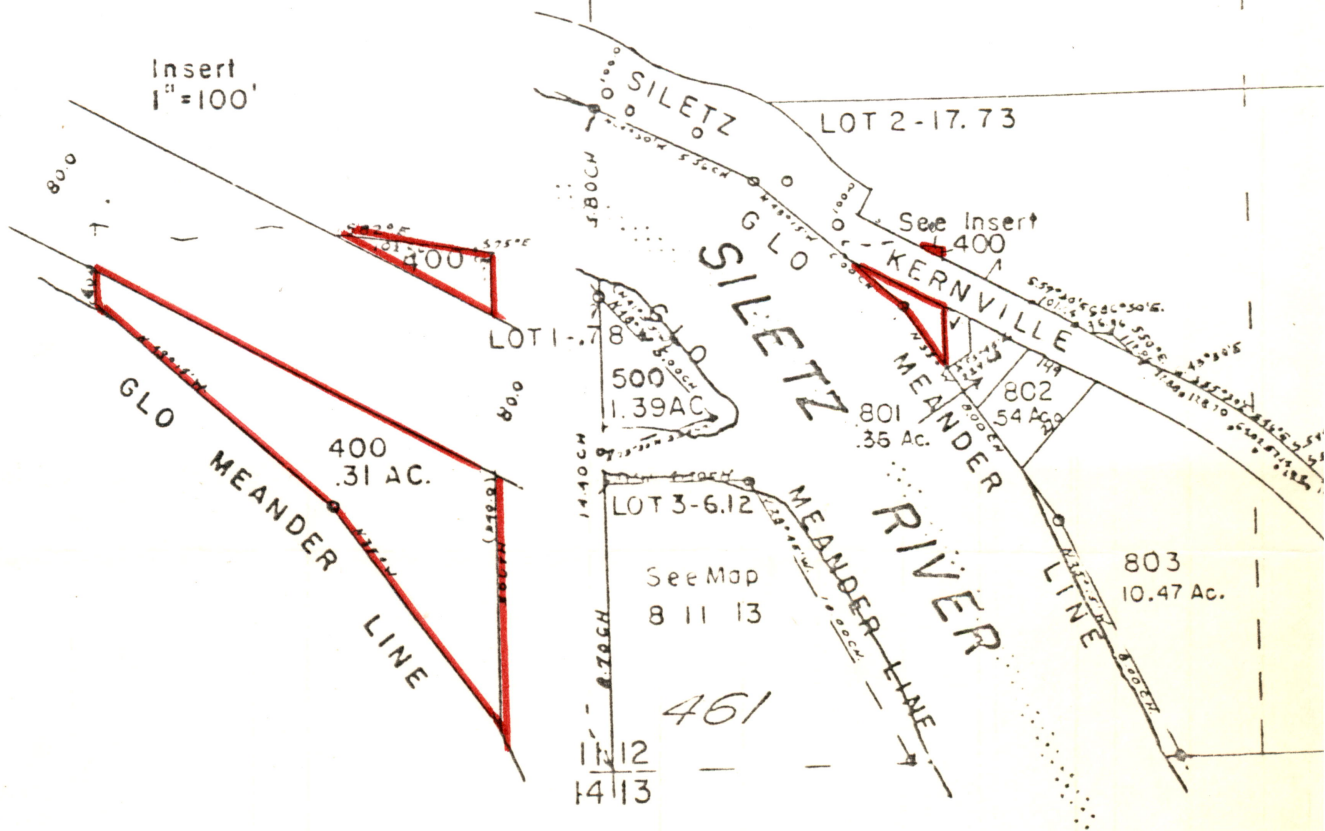


Dear Mr. Gilfillan:

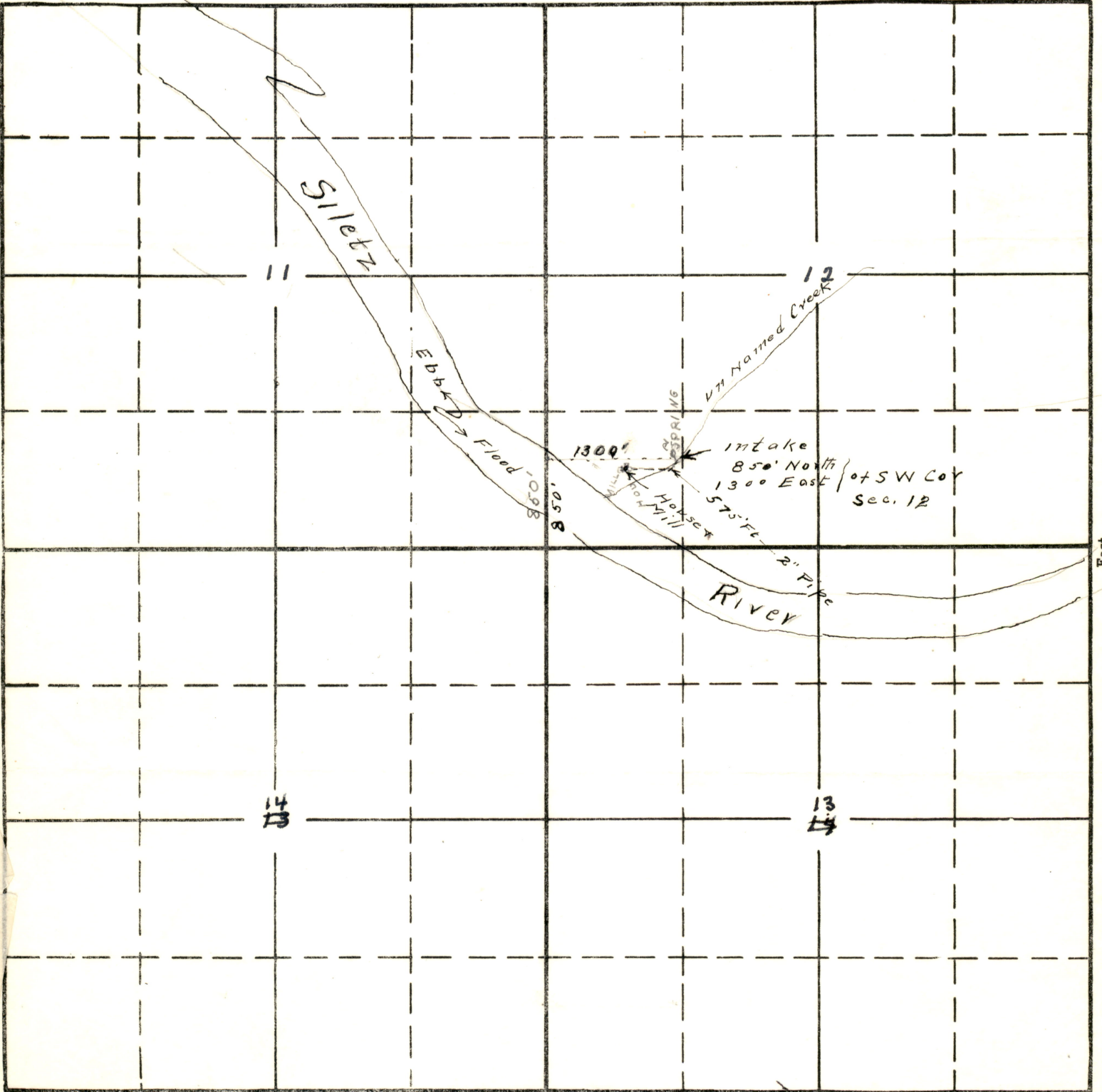

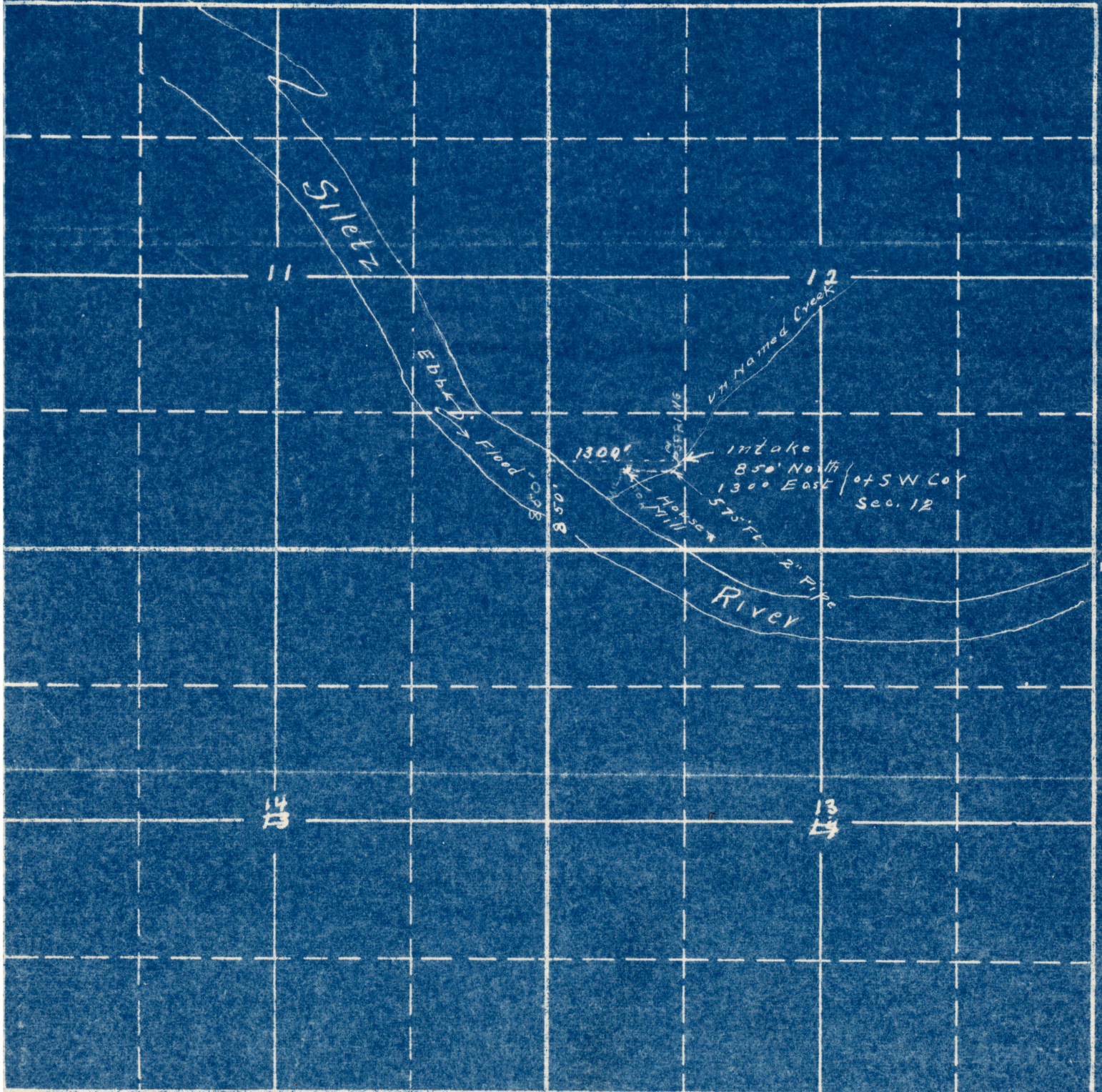
