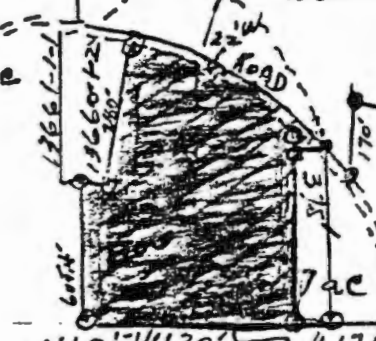

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.51 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Davis Creek and Shortridge Reservoir constructed under permit No. R-1656.

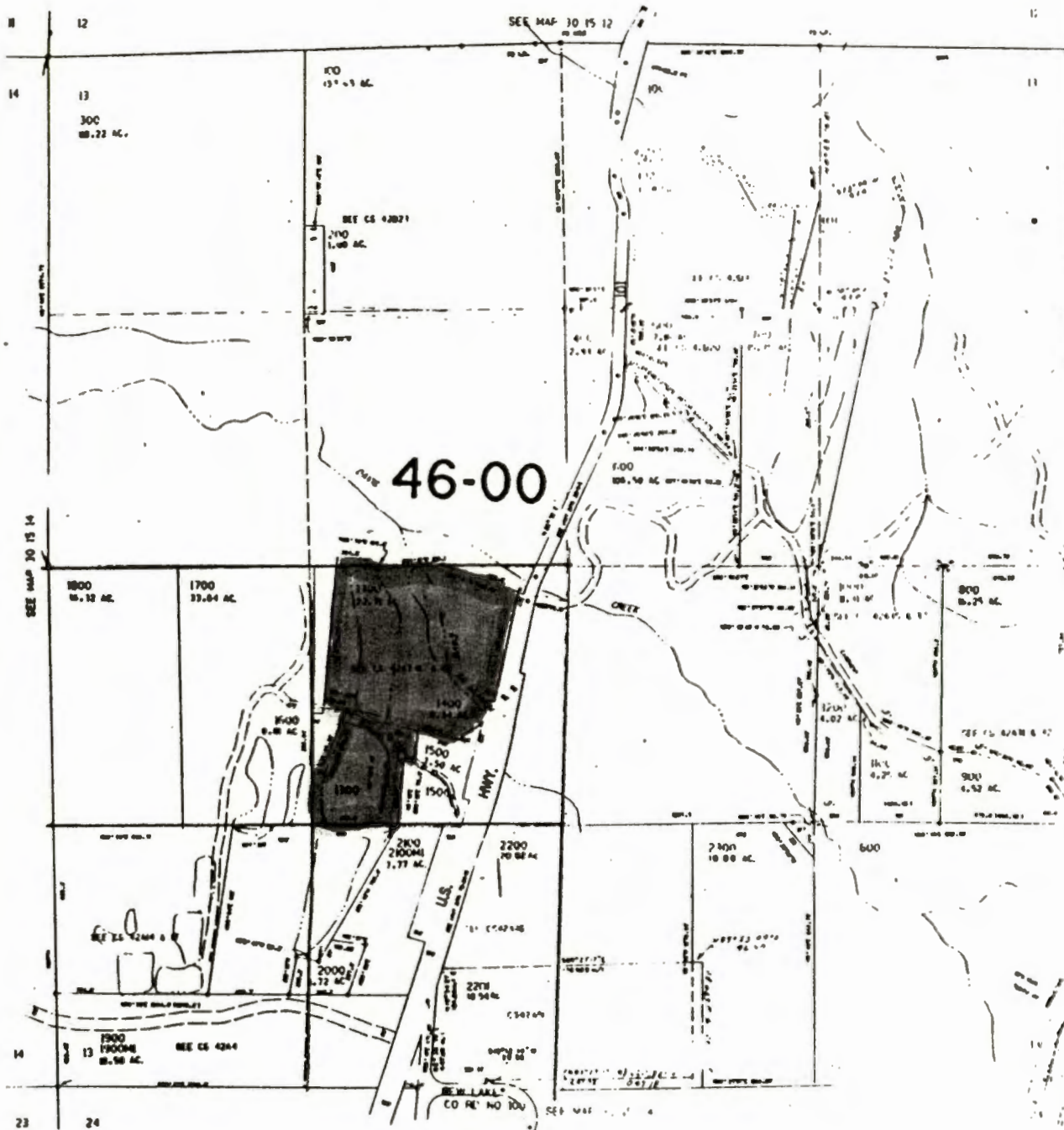

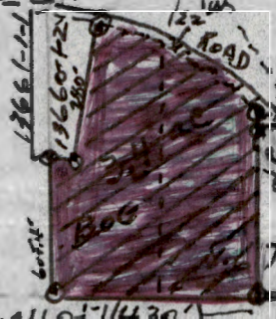

Dear Mr. Shortridge:

This will acknowledge your map, fees of \$45.00 and an application for a permit to appropriate 0.8 cubic foot per second of water from Davis Creek and Shortridge Reservoir for irrigation and temperature control on an unspecified number of acres of cranberries.

Your existing water rights indicate that Davis Creek flows through your reservoir and you are appropriating water from Davis Creek and the reservoir. According to your application map, your reservoir is on an unnamed tributary of Davis Creek. I believe since previous rights indicate the reservoir to be located on Davis Creek, your application map should show Davis Creek running through the reservoir. Otherwise your source of water should be indicated as an unnamed stream tributary to Davis Creek.
