

SUBJECT: Harbor Bench Critical Ground Water Area

Since the determination of the proposed critical ground water area for the Harbor Bench has now been made, and it has been concluded that no critical ground water area exists. A permit can be issued in approval of application No. G-7402.

Application No. G-7402 was originally intended to be primary and application No. 54342 was intended to be supplemental. Both applications were filed on the same date.

Since a permit could not be issued in approval of application No. G-7402 until such time as the critical ground water determination was made. A permit was issued in approval of application No. 54342 as primary irrigation.

In accordance with my letter of August 3, 1976 to Pete Cowan, permit issued in approval of application No. 54342 is to be considered supplemental at such time as a permit is issued in approval of G-7402.

A permit will now be issued in approval of application No. G-7402. Therefore, permit No. 40797 is to be considered supplemental.

Harbor Bench Status

Annual ground water level declines on the Harbor Bench average approximately 4.6 inches. This decline appears at this time to be attributable to the occurrence of less than average rainfall over the last five years. It is anticipated that a return to average precipitation will result in termination of the water level decline. No critical ground water area is currently being proposed for the Harbor Bench. As a result, there need be no further delay in issuing ground water permits on the bench.

Dear Mr. Cowan:

This will acknowledge your maps, fees of \$85.00 and applications for permits to appropriate 0.32 cubic foot per second of water from Johnson Creek for irrigation of 25.75 acres; the appropriations of 0.42 cubic foot per second of water, being 0.21 cfs from an unnamed stream and 0.21 cfs from a spring for irrigation of 21.5 acres and supplemental mirrigation of 12 acres; also to appropriate 0.075 cfs of water from a well for irrigation of 6 acres. These applications have been filed as No. 54341, No. 54342, and No. G-7402, respectively.

Your applications to appropriate fwater from Johnson Creek, the unnamed stream and the spring are in satisfactory form for approval by issuance of permits.

Permits will be issued for use of water from Johnson Creek and its tributaries with the understanding that water may not be available during the dry periods of the irrigation season. The available water may be needed to satisfy existing rights or meet minimum flow standards established.

Your proposed well would be located within the proposed Brookings-Harbor Critical Ground Water Area currently under investigation. It is recommended that this well not be constructed until such time as a final determination has been made regarding the ground water in this vicinity.

A permit in approval of your application No. G-7402 will not be issued until such time as the final determination has been made.

Your application No. 54342, which requests a permit, in part, for supplemental irrigation of the land described by your application No. G-7402, has been amended to request a permit for primary irrigation of the 6 acres described by this well and supplemental irrigation of 6 acres described by previous rights.

If, at a later date, a permit is issued in approval of your application No. G-7402 for primary irrigation, the permit issued in approval of application No. 54342 can be amended so as to describe supplemental irrigation of the entire 12 acre parcel.
