Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.01⁰⁰⁴ cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from North Umpqua River

A TRIBUTARY OF UMPQUA RIVER

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation of 0.3 acre

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is March 30, 1981

Actual construction work shall begin on or before April 30, 1982 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1983

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1984

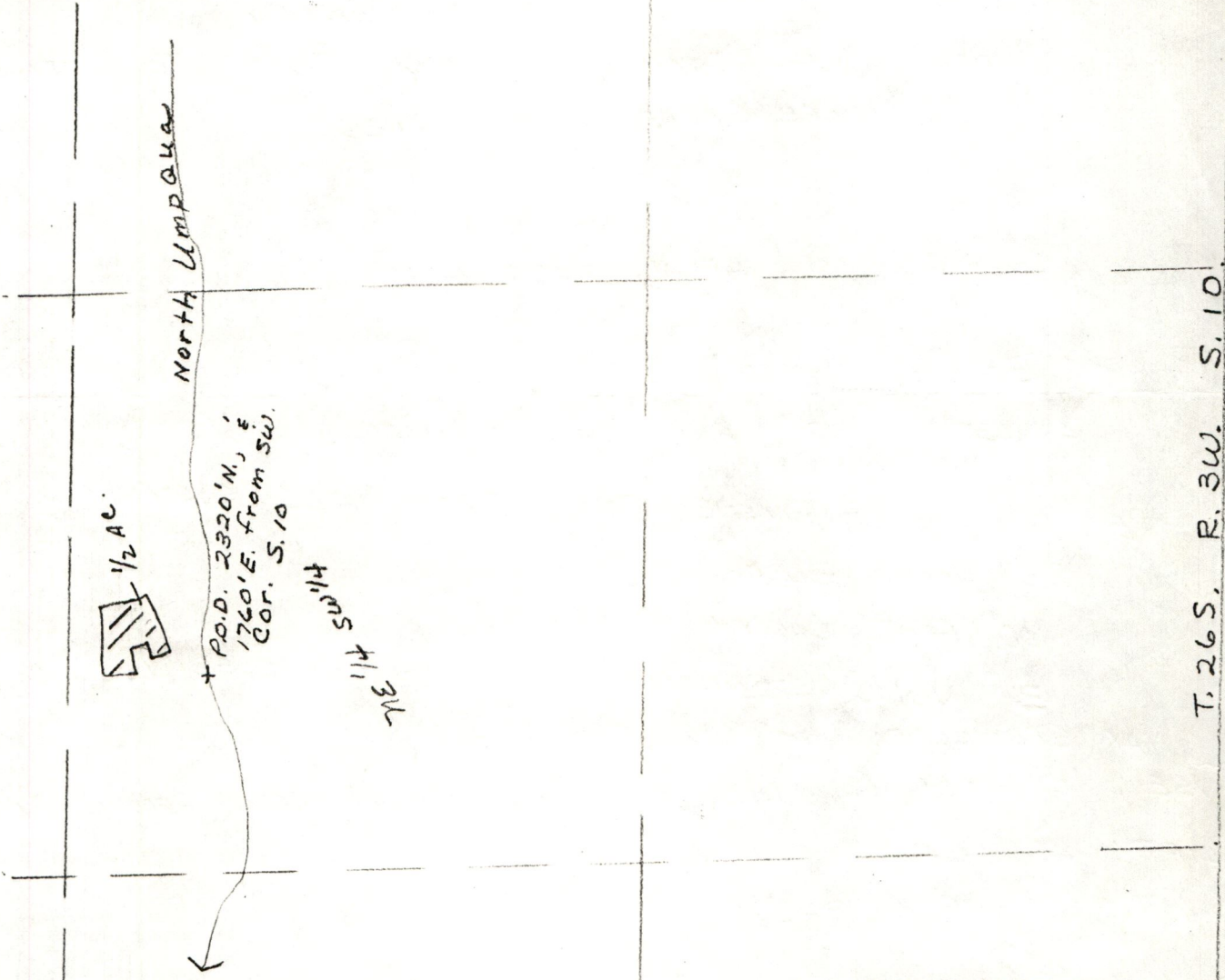

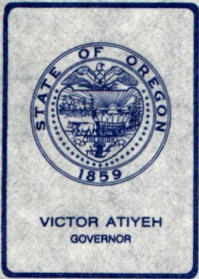

On April 6, 1987, we mailed you the proof of appropriation of water form in connection with your permit No. 45662 together with the instruction that it be examined, signed and returned.

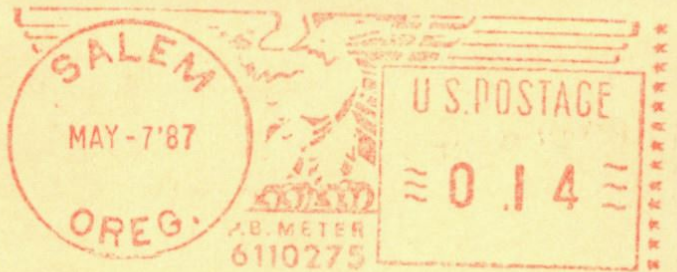

Commencing at the quarter corner between Sections 9 and 10, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon, and running South 74°44' East 1888.7 feet to a 30 inch white oak stump, said stump being the most westerly Northwest corner of a tract surveyed by H. L. Eppstein in Section 10, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, Willamette Meridian, on February 16, 1931; thence North 47°15' East 262.3 feet to a one inch iron rod, said rod being set on the Southerly line of the North Umpqua Highway, 50 feet from the centerline of said highway at Engineer's centerline Station 1050+00, said one inch iron rod being the point of beginning; thence along the arc of a 5779.58 foot radius curve to the left, (the long chord of which bears South 86°14'45" East) 135.00 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod; thence South 2°25'00" West 60.00 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod; thence continuing South 2°25' West 381.0 feet, more or less, to the South line of the Forrest Kennaday property; thence in a Westerly direction along said south line to the Southwest corner of said Kennaday property; thence North 2°25' East along the West line of said Kennaday property 332.0 feet, more or less, to a 1/2 inch iron rod; thence continuing along said West line North 2°25' East 124.80 feet to the point of beginning, all lying in Section 10, Township 26 South, Range 3 West, Willamette Meridian, Douglas County, Oregon.

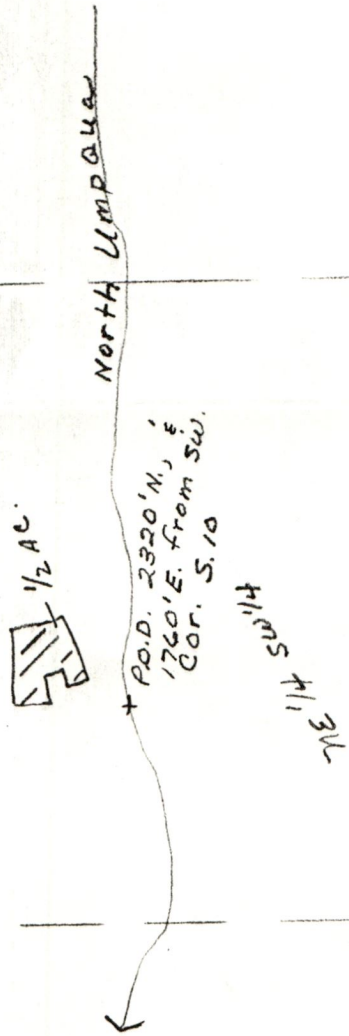
