Dear Mr. Hickam:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of January 25, 1965 in regard to water permit number 16927 in the name of Wava Haga Chesley.

Since this permit is confirmed by a water right certificate recorded at page 15680, State Record of Water Right Certificates, it will not be necessary for you to make any kind of transfer from Mr. or Mrs. Chesley to you. There is no statutory procedure for assigning a certificate of water right to a new owner. You acquire the right which is appurtenant to the property which you purchase.

The water right which you describe in your letter of January 25, has a priority date of March 20, 1946. The right is for the use of 0.01 c.f.s. from an unnamed stream for domestic supply. (0.01 c.f.s. equals approximately $4\frac{1}{2}$ gallons per minute) This appears to be the only water right that has been filed on this property.

As far as the records of this office are concerned, this water right is valid and in good standing.





If the administrator of the estate or owners of the property involved under Permit No. 14128 will sign and date the enclosed final proof on its second sheet and return the proof to this office together with the statutory certificate recording fee of \$1.00, a certificate confirming the right under your Permit No. 14128, covering a use of 17 gallons per minute from an unnamed branch for domestic purposes, will be issued.

This report has been filed and your permit is in good standing until October 1, 1942, when under its terms construction should be complete.

Complete application of water should be made, according to the terms of your permit, on or before October 1, 1943.
