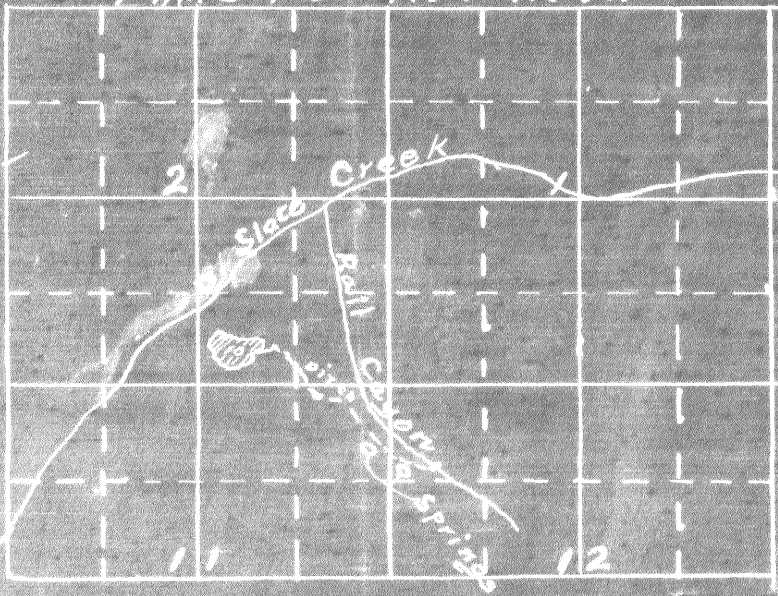

Upon receipt of tracing the application will be taken up for approval.

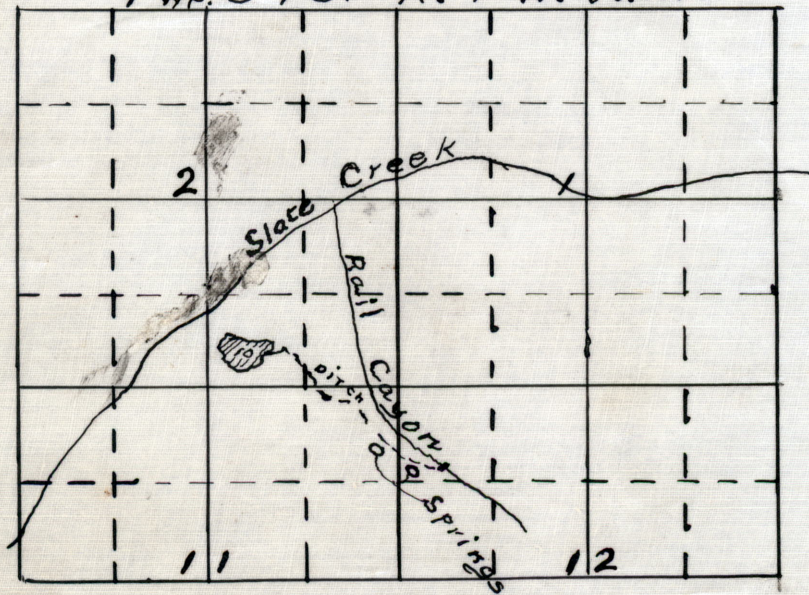
