Notification of Specific-to-General Industrial Water Use Change

for Certificate 37577

Dear Mr. Starnes;

Collins Timber Company, LLC (Collins) is the holder of Certificate 37577, which authorizes the use of up to 20.4 cfs of water from the Klamath River for "cooling, manufacturing and boiler feed." The water right allows a rate of up to 18.0 cfs for cooling purposes and up to 2.4 cfs for manufacturing and boiler feed purposes. A copy of Certificate 37577 is enclosed.

On behalf of Collins, I am requesting that the Oregon Water Resources Department (OWRD) accept this notification of a change from specific industrial use to general industrial use under certificate 37577, as provided under ORS 540.520(9) and OAR 690-380-2340. Based on this notification, Collins intends to use up to 20.4 cfs for general industrial purposes within the current facility owned by Collins Timber Company. Please find below the information required by this statute and rule.

a) Name and address of the person (entity) using water under the water right:

c) A description of the location of the industrial facility owned by the holder of the original water right at the time the water right permit was issued:

Weyerhaeuser Company was the holder of the original permit (Permit S-33181) at the time it was issued (July 22, 1968). At that time, Weyerhaeuser owned the property that is located in tax lot 4300, Sections 13 and 24, Township 39 South, Range 8 East, and tax lot 1000, Section 18, Township 39 South, Range 9 East. (See enclosed map.) Weyerhaeuser sold its interest in the property to Collins Products LLC, now Collins Timber Company LLC, on August 31, 1996. Collins has continued to own and operate the mill facilities in the same location.

d) The quantity of water diverted to satisfy the authorized specific use under the original water right:

The total quantity of water to satisfy the specific uses under Certificate 37577 was 20.4 cfs. The quantity of water diverted to satisfy the use of water for cooling purposes was 18.0 cfs. The quantity of water to satisfy the use of water for manufacturing and boiler feed was 2.4 cfs.

e) A description of the general industrial use to be made of the water after the change:

Collins will use water for general industrial purposes at the mill facilities located within tax lot 4300, Sections 13 and 24, Township 39 South, Range 8 East, and tax lot 1000, Section 18, Township 39 South, Range 9 East. The intended general industrial uses may include, but are not limited to construction, operation and maintenance of the industrial site, charging the fire suppression system, and product processing. The quantity of water to be used for the general industrial use under water right certificate 37577 will not exceed 20.4 cfs.

This Is to Certify, That

WEYERHAEUSER COMPANY,

a Washington Corporation
of Tacoma , State of Washington has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Klamath River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean cooling, menufacturing and boiler feed

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 33181 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 26, 1968

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 20.4 cubic feet per second, being 16.0 c.f.s. for cooling and 2.4 c.f.s. for manufacturing and boiler feed

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Lot 3 (NWM NEW), Section 24, T. 59 S., R. 8 E.,

W. M. Diversion point located: 615 feet South and 1640 feet West from NE Corner,
Section 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ _ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
