Water Right Ownership Update Form

Notice To Sellers & Buyers:

By law, all water belongs to the public [ORS 537.110]. In almost every instance, a permit ("water right") from the Water Resources Department is needed before using, diverting, or storing any water [ORS 537.130]. However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A water right stays with the property. In order to keep track of water right ownership, ORS 537.330 requires persons selling property having a water right to: 1) provide evidence of the water right to the buyer and 2) notify the Water Resources Department of the water right involved with the real estate transaction. Sellers are exempted from this requirement if a water district or a municipal source serves their water uses.

Water that has been used for a long period of time in one place or that involves a water structure (like a dam or well) that already exists is no guarantee that there is a water right which would allow the water use to continue.
