

During our telephone discussion several months ago, I pointed out to you that under the terms of permit 31806 only 12.6 acres were found to have been irrigated from the unnamed spring. As a matter of fact, we have your letter dated March 15, 1977 to the effect that less than 20 acres had been irrigated.

A second permit was issued to you on May 22, 1978. Permit \$3013 allows the use of water from springs numbered one and two and an unnamed stream for the irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 50 acres and fish propagation. The portion referred to as supplemental irrigation under permit \$3013 would be the same lands as described as primary irrigation under your permit \$1806. The balance of the primary irrigation will be covered under your permit \$3013.

Because of recent budget cuts, we will be unable to make another trip in connection with your permit 31806. When you advise us that the terms of your most recent permit 43013 have been met, we will be able to make a final proof inspection.

Just as soon as you sign and return a proof form sent in connection with your permit 31806, we will be able to proceed with the issuance of your certificate of water right. This will eliminate the need for further notices or correspondence in connection with said permit.







Just in case something unforeseen happens, I would like to get the following down on paper in the event you need it in the future.

In the summer of 1971 I helped Lindsey D. Ruck install a pump and piping to irrigate the upper side hill and helped him dig a ditch to flood irrigate the lower fields. The source of the water supply was the spring about 3/4 mile up the access road from the house and the natural stream running through the property adjacent to the spring.

In effect, at least 50 acres were irrigated from these sources for at least 2 years prior to your buying the place from Lindsey Ruck. There was evidence someone had irrigated the upper side hill previously, but I do not know it for a fact.

Dear Mr. Ruck:

I have your letter stating that you will abandon the use of water under permit 31806 but before we take action on the cancelation of this I have another question.

A right can be perfected to the extent the use of water is made within the time limits and terms of a permit. When the last application for extension of time you stated that you had irrigated 15 to 20 acres and had considerable amount of equipment. If you wish to continue the irrigation of that land to previously irrigated, you could perfect a right to that extent and drop the balance. If the permit is canceled you would not be able to irrigate that land previously irrigated unless a new permit was obtained. If you have abandoned future irrigation then the permit should be canceled but if you have irrigated part of the land and wish to continue that part you should notify us as to what had been irrigated October 1, 1970, and include a statement that you wish to complete your right only to that extent.

Dear Mr Jones,

I have completed irrigating approximately 15+ acresand have equipment to do a little more. We originally had plan to irrigate 50 acres, but realize the cost was prohibitive. I now believe that moreland can be irrigated thru the use of an old ditch which can be reestablished. I should be able to irrigate 5-10 more acres by flooding if my calculations are correct. Gene Hickman of the Soil Conservation Dept. suggested this plan when I first started. I didn't take his advice but nowrealize he was right.

I would also like more time to add valves etc. to the 20 acres nowset up. We intend to add \$12-1500.00 more this spring to existing irrigation equipment.

We did have more equipment prior to October 1, 1968 but due to illnessI had to liquidate (sell) some of my irrigation equipment. We are now financially able to add to and refine the existing equipment.

In reference to the upper ditch that I intend to reopen; during the spring and early summer there is a surplus of water but mid-summer the ditch would be useless. At that time I would irrigate only the 20 acres below from sump with pumps and sprinklers.

This will acknowledge an imcomplete application for the extension of the time limits to complete the use of water under your permit number 31806 and the fee of \$5.00 for which our receipt number 16949 is enclosed.

When you filed the notice of completion of construction last year you included the statement that you did not think that there was enough water from the sump to irrigate 50 acres but thought there was enough for 20 acres which was sufficient for your needs and you said that you had the necessary equipment for the 20 acres.

On the application for extension of time you say that you have irrigated 15 to 20 acres. The time limit to complete construction which means you have obtained all the necessary irrigation equipment is October 1, 1968.

Your application for extension of time does not indicate whether or not you have obtained additional equipment but if this was not done you would also need extension of the time limit to complete construction if the permit was to be maintained for more than the land presently irrigated. If there is not enough water for irrigation of more than approxamately 20 acres and you have not and do not intend to obtain more equipment then the extension of the time limits to complete the use of water would not be required. I do not have enough information avaliable to make any statement as to the probable best course of action but in the event that you do wish to continue the development of this project I am returning the application for extension of time so you may add additional information particularly in regard as to what has been done in the way of acquisition of equipment.
