During our telephone discussion several months ago, I pointed out to you that under the terms of permit 31806 only 12.6 acres were found to have been irrigated from the unnamed spring. As a matter of fact, we have your letter dated March 15, 1977 to the effect that less than 20 acres had been irrigated.

A second permit was issued to you on May 22, 1978. Permit 43013 allows the use of water from springs numbered one and two and an unnamed stream for the irrigation and supplemental irrigation of 50 acres and fish propagation. The portion referred to as supplemental irrigation under permit 43013 would be the same lands as described as primary irrigation under your permit 31806. The balance of the primary irrigation will be covered under your permit 43013.

Because of recent budget cuts, we will be unable to make another trip in connection with your permit 31806. When you advise us that the terms of your most recent permit 43013 have been met, we will be able to make a final proof inspection.
