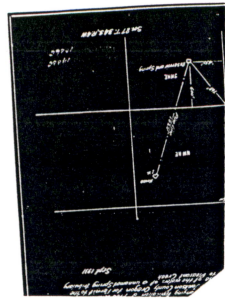

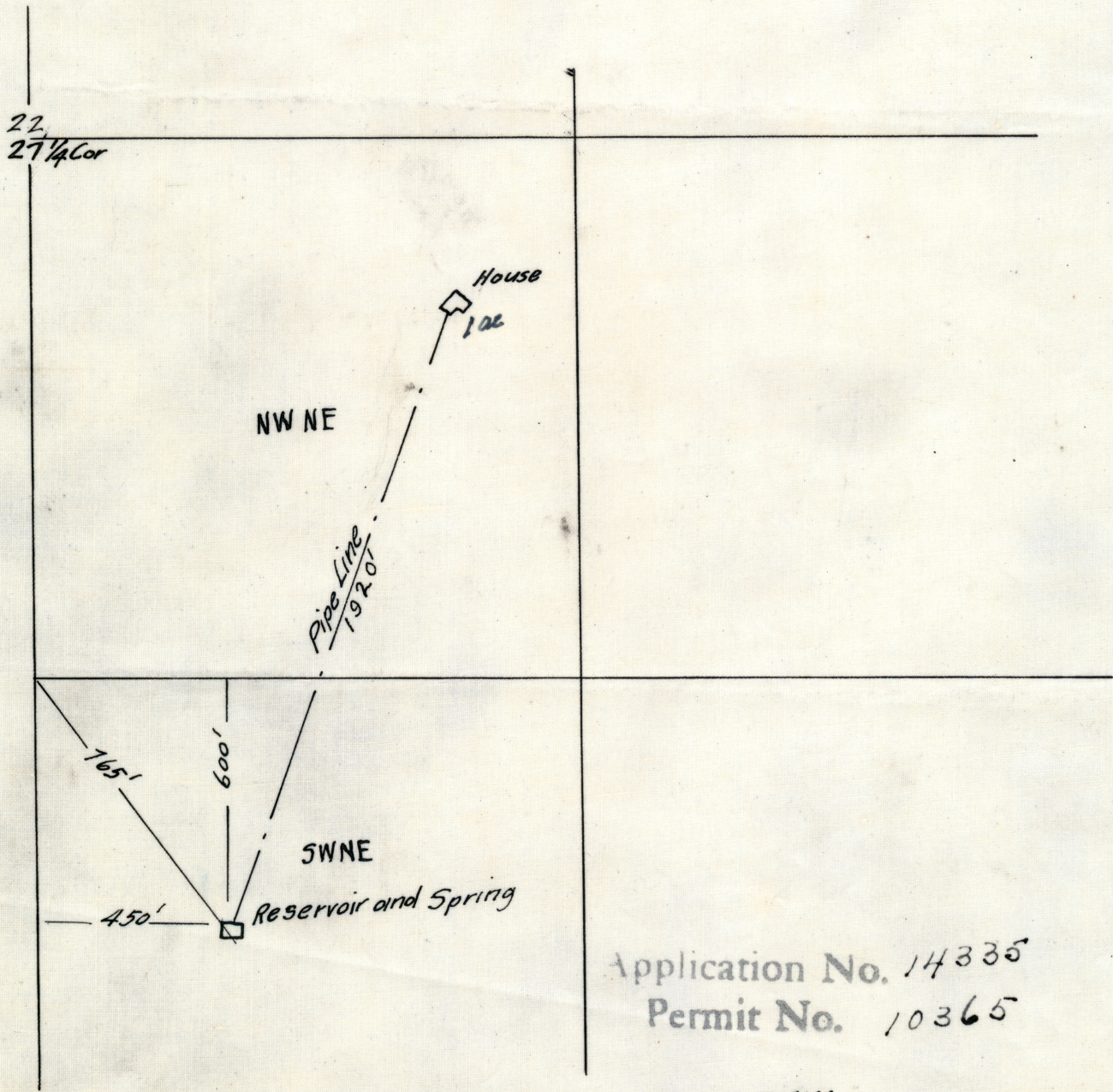

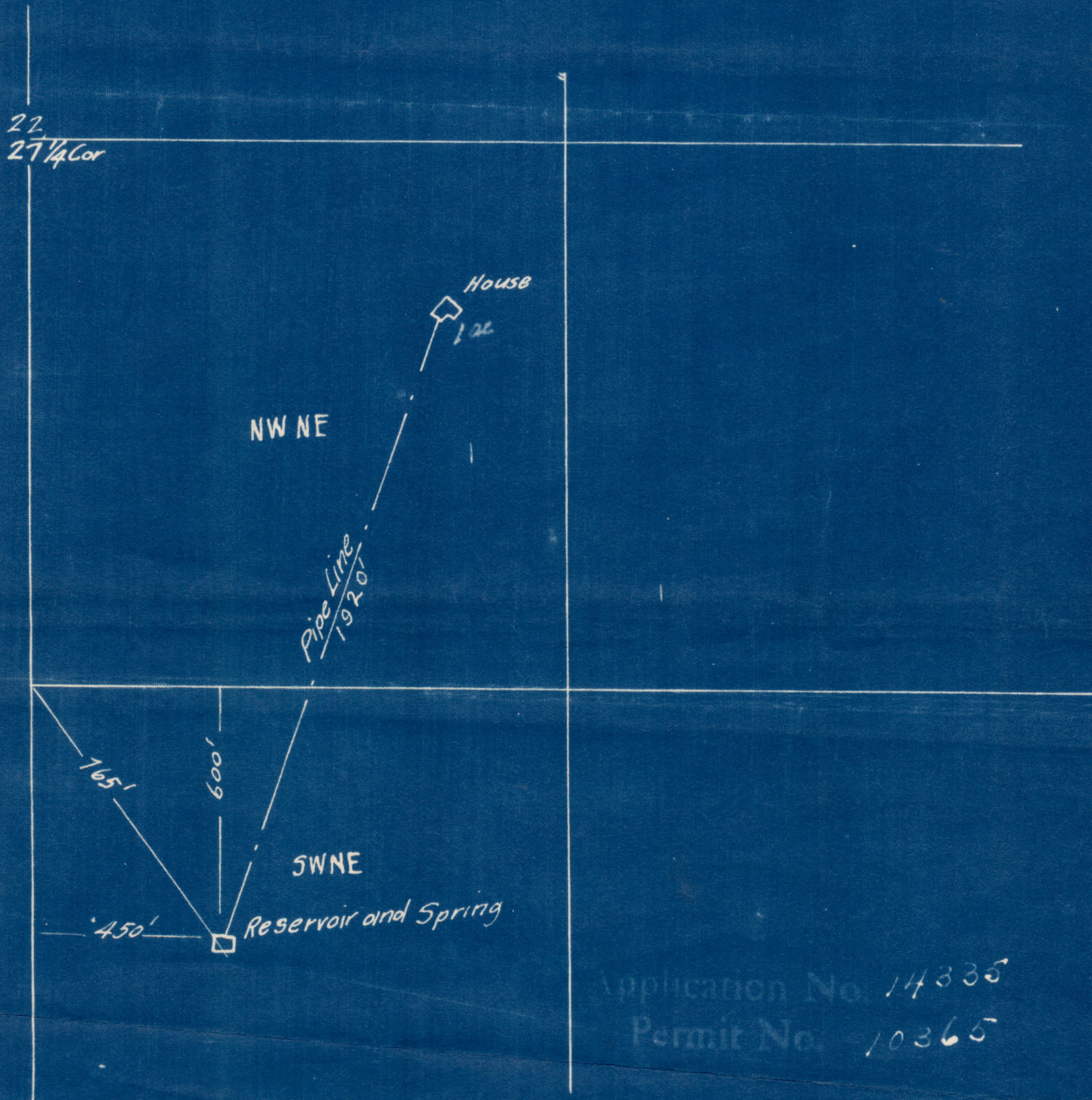

ABSTRACT OF CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT NO. 10187

Fred Witt of Rogue River
State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of
the State Engineer of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Unnamed spring
a tributary of Pleasant Creek for the purpose of
Domestic and garden irrigation
under Permit No. 10365 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the
use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon;
that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
September 24, 1931;
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby con-
firmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually bene-
ficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot
per second or its equivalent in case of rotation.
The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, Township
34 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount
secured under any other right existing for the same lands shall be limited
to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper
State officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed,
and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

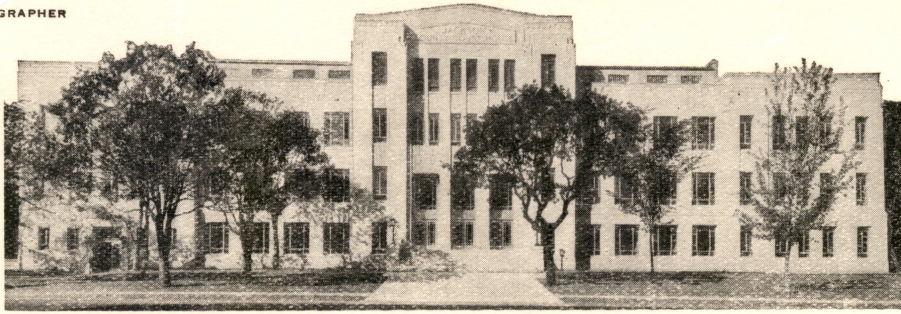

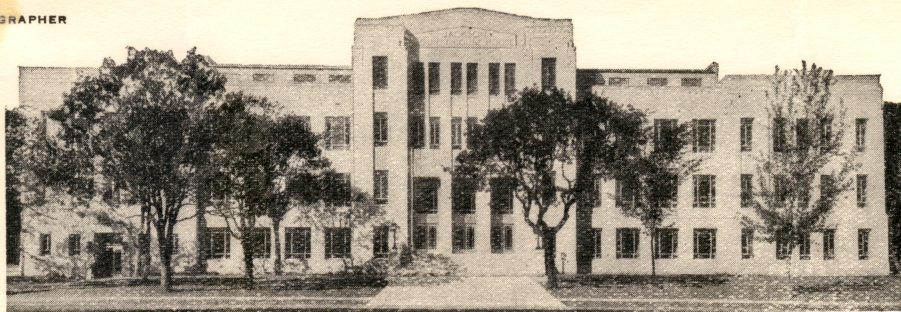
