- 5. Notice of the application for substitution was published on December 28, 2010, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 6. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 7. A diversion structure and ditch sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing primary surface water rights is present, and a pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing supplemental ground water right is present.
- 8. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights
- 9. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The substitution of the supplemental ground water right for the primary surface water rights proposed in application T-11169 is consistent with the requirements of 540.524 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The substitution of a supplemental ground water right for primary surface water rights proposed in application T-11169 is approved and shall be effective upon issuance of this order.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 67723, 46570, 76667, and any related decree.

3. The substitution of a supplemental ground water right for the primary surface water rights may be terminated upon a request by the water right holder. The substitution also may be terminated by an order of the Director if the Director determines the use of the ground water as the primary water right causes injury to other water rights. Upon termination, the substituted primary and supplemental water rights shall revert to their original status.







We have noted your change on our records. The change will be allowed provided we do not receive any protest or that it does not injure other water users.
