





Authority

Findings of Fact

1. On January 17, 2014, RALPH STAVER AND WADE AVERY filed an application to change the point of diversion under Certificate 19687, and add additional points of diversion under Certificates 43759, and 57584. The Department assigned the application number T-11726.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on February 4, 2014, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. On June 30, 2014, the Department contacted the applicant's agent by telephone and by written correspondence to notify the applicants of deficiencies in the application. The deficiencies included, but were not limited to: the application should not include Certificate 57584, however it should include Certificate 57255; there were quarter quarters that were mis-labeled; the acres on the application and map were not all labeled; not all of the point of diversions were shown on the transfer map and it was not clear what changes the applicants wanted to make. The Department requested that the deficiencies be resolved by July 31, 2014. After additional communication and upon additional requests the date was eventually extended to October 8, 2014. On September 26, 2014, the Department received amended application pages and a revised map resolving the deficiencies. One of the revisions added Colleen Avery as an applicant.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

4. On October 9, 2014, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11726 to the applicants. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of November 10, 2014, for the applicants to respond. Upon request of the applicants, the deadline was extended to December 10, 2014. The applicants requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicants are authorized to pursue the transfer.

5. On January 6, 2015, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-11726 and sent a copy to the applicants. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on January 13, 2015, and in the Medford Mail Tribune newspaper on January 17 and 24, 2015, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

This diversion may be eligible for screening cost-share funds.

Transfer Review Criteria [OAR 690-380-4010(2)]

15. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
16. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-11726.
17. The proposed changes would not result in enlargement of the rights.
18. The proposed changes would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law


The change in point of diversion and additional points of diversion proposed in Transfer Application T-11726 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The change in point of diversion and additional points of diversion proposed in Transfer Application T-11726 are approved.
2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 19687, 43759, and 57255 and any related decree.
3. Water Right Certificates 19687, 43759, and 57255 are cancelled.
4. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the original point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion.
5. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. **Before water use may begin** under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

6. Prior to diverting water, the water user shall install an approved fish screen at the new point of diversion and shall provide to the OWRD a written statement from Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) that the installed screen meets the state's criteria, or that ODFW has determined a screen is not necessary.
7. The water user shall operate and maintain the fish screen at the new point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards. If ODFW determines the screen is not functioning properly, and is unsuccessful in working with the water user to meet ODFW standards, ODFW may request that OWRD regulate the use of water until OWRD receives notification from ODFW that the fish screen is functioning properly.
8. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2016**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
9. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.








Map to accompany application of Mrs. John S. Byrnes for use of water from Palmer Creek for irrigation and domestic purposes.


