There is no defined stream, but since surface water is available from Sep. 1 – Jun. 30, a standard rate is requested from run-off when water is available for both irrigation and agricultural uses. The reservoir would be used as a bulge in the system and everything will still be diverted from the POD on the reservoir. For the season when water is unavailable, only the storage authorized under Permit R-15566 will be used; however, the full irrigation season and year-round agricultural use are requested from this storage as well not to exceed 10 acrefeet between both uses. This will give the water user the flexibility to use storage water whenever run-off does not occur.

### MEMORANDUM OF LAND SALE CONTRACT

THIS MEMORANDUM, made this 20 day of April, 2022, by and between Abundio Perez and Melanie Perez (collectively hereinafter "Purchaser"), and Shelley L. Hines (hereinafter "Seller"), for recording purposes acknowledges that a Contract for the sale of real property, dated the 20 day of April, 2022, was entered into wherein the total consideration is the sum of \$299,900.00, or such amount as is stated in the contract, payable in installments as therein stated, with a final payment due on or before June 1, 2027, unless otherwise extended by agreement. The interest conveyed to the Purchaser is equitable title in the following described real property, identified by Polk County as Parcel (Tax Account No.) 384148, Tax Lot 632900 2503, Salem, Polk County, Oregon, to-wit:
