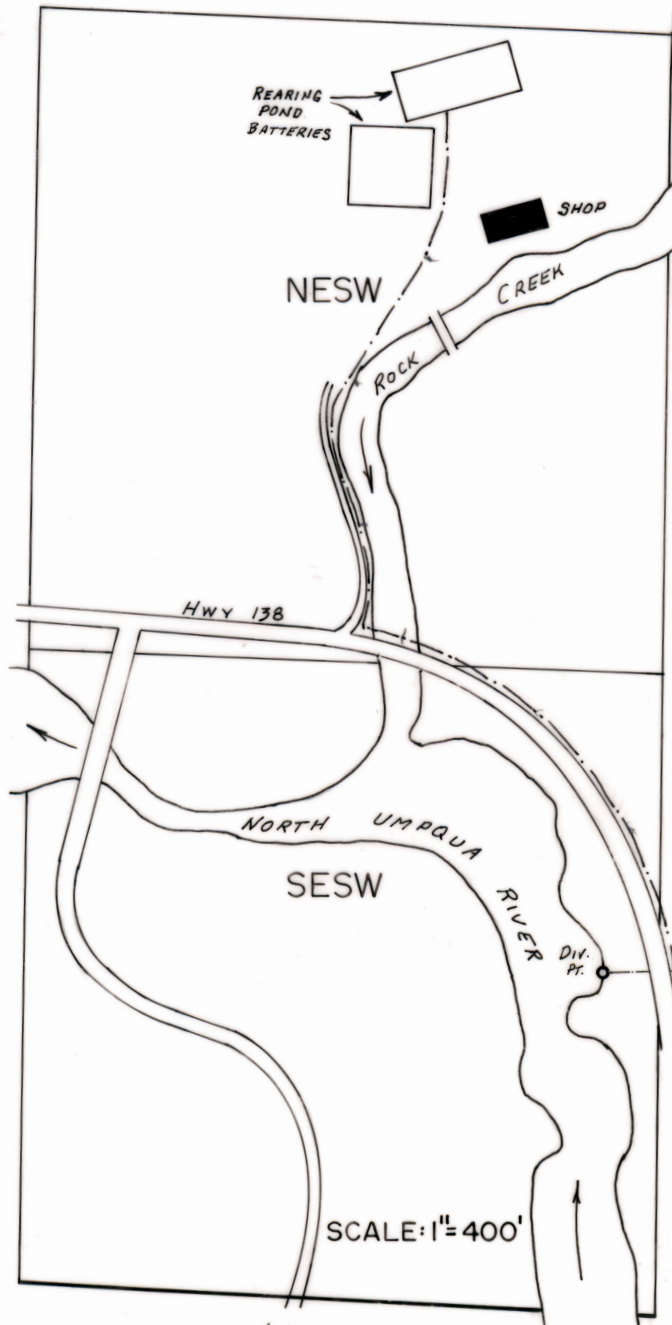

permit; that the priority of the right dates from
August 28, 1978

that the amount of water for the purposes aforesaid, has been actually beneficially used in the amount of
5800 acre-feet stored water only

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of
diversion is located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 30, T27S, R6E, WM; 150
feet North and 250 feet East from the SW Corner, Section 30. Water released
from Diamond Lake Reservoir into the North Umpqua River rediverted at a point
located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 1, T26S, R3W, WM; 1955 feet South and
110 feet West from the center 1/4 corner, Section 1.



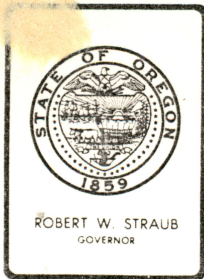

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 5800 ACRE FEET STORED WATER ONLY cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from Diamond Lake Reservoir to be constructed under application No. R-57860, permit No. R-7734, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5800 a.f. per year. TRIB LAKE CR.

The use to which this water is to be applied is fish propagation at Rock Creek Hatchery trib Lake Creek (North Clatsop River)

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is August 28, 1978

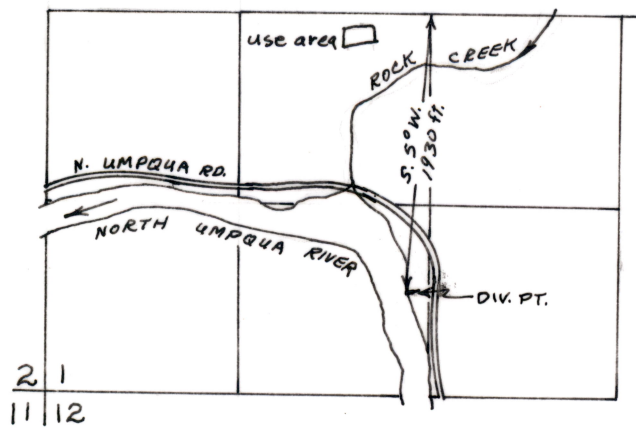
Actual construction work shall begin on or before November 30, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1980

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1981

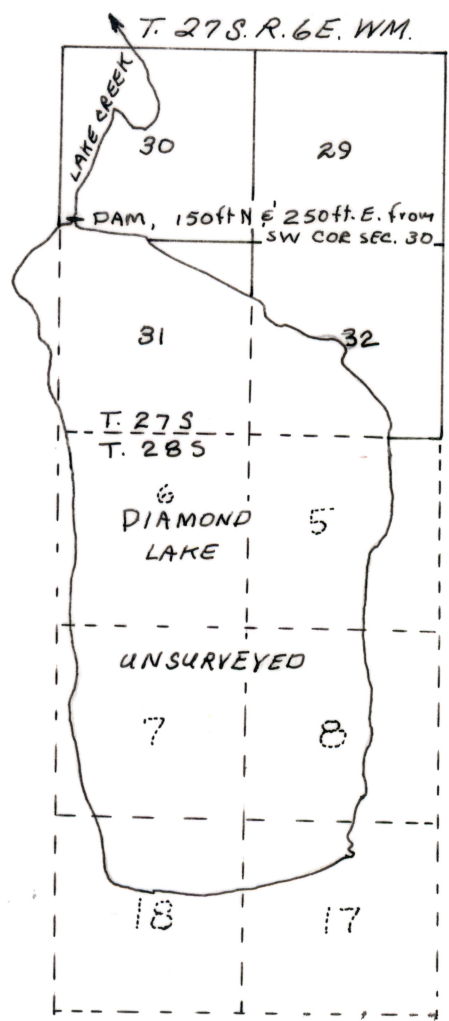

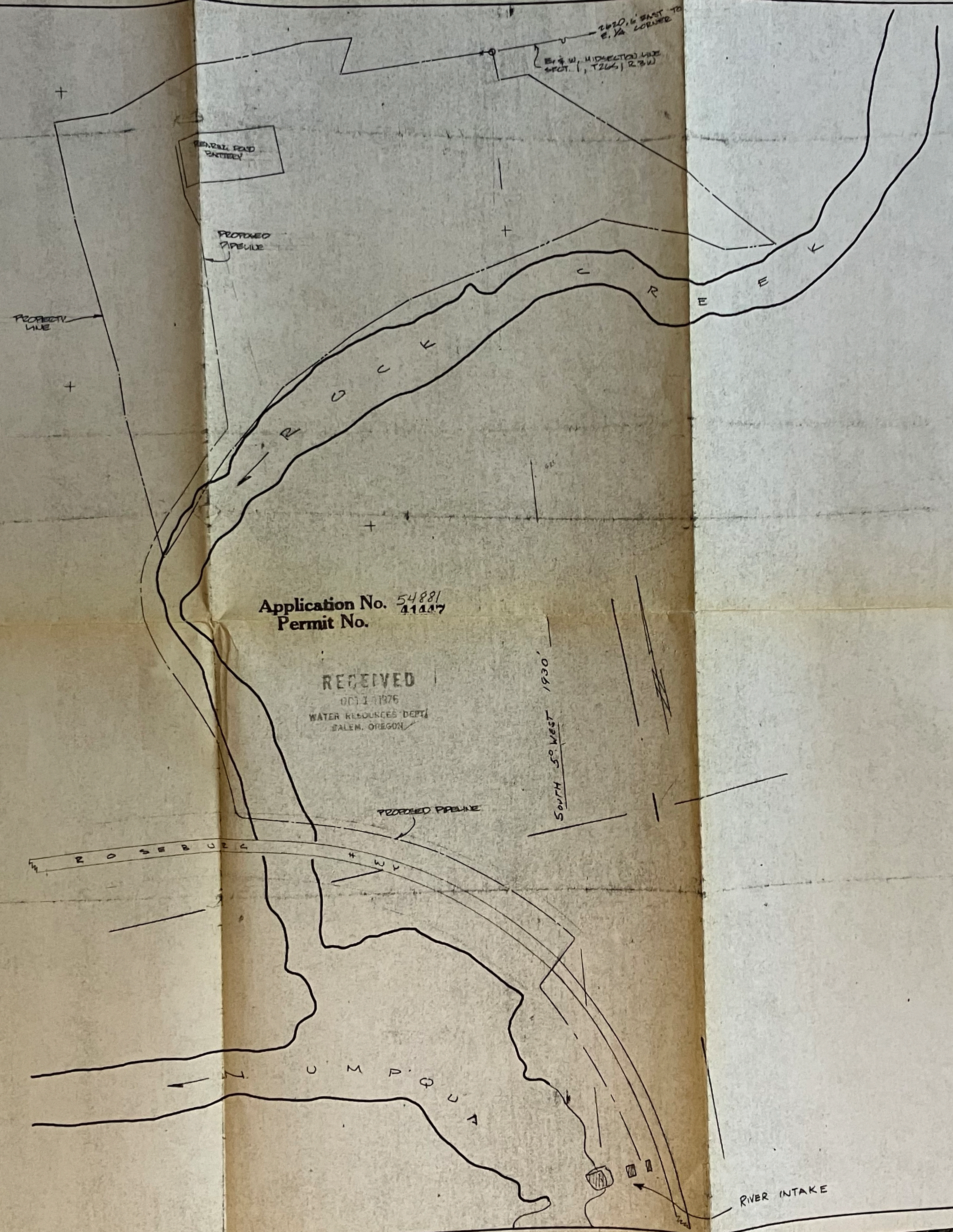
