ORDER

On February 26, 1976, George W. Sickler of 7171 Holland Loop Road, Cave Junction, Oregon 97523, submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of the Circuit Court for Josephine County, entered May 11, 1914, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Althouse Creek, tabulated in the name of Mary Ellen Leonard, at page 219, Volume 1, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, and is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 2716, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Mary Ellen Leonard, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.45 cubic foot per second of water from Althouse Creek, with a date of priority of 1858, for irrigation of 22.6 acres in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 4, Township 40 South, Range 7 West, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 2716, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of the water right NOT involved in this proceeding.



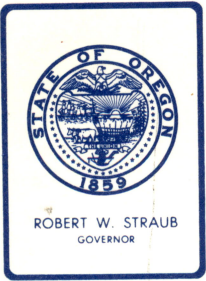

Dear Mr. Sickler:

Your application for a permit to appropriate 135 gallons of water per minute from Sump Wells No. 1 and 2 for the irrigation of 17 acres has been filed as number G-7151. We have also received a property description, reproducible map, and the fees of \$30.00.

During our telephone discussion the other day, it was my understanding that water from Althouse Creek as described under certificate of water right recorded on Page 2716, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates, would not be used on your lands and that the sump wells would be the only sources of supply. In order to clear our records of the earlier water right, I have enclosed an affidavit of abandonment for your use. Please sign it in the presence of a Notary Public and return it at your earliest convenience. We will also have to issue a certificate covering the lands not involved in the cancellation and for this we will need a certificate recording fee of \$2.00.

A specific amount of water to be appropriated from each sump well must also be given on your application. If you will send us this information, I will add it to your application.

Your permit, when issued, will limit the appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

Further action will be held on your application for a reasonable length of time pending receipt of the notarized statement and additional information.
