This is in reply to your letter of December 31st stating that the construction work is already completed and that the water was applied on June 20, 1935, under your Permit No. 11489.

Your letter does not state whether or not all of the lands were irrigated, but I presume so, and I am therefore enclosing a form for your convenience in submitting proof. 


