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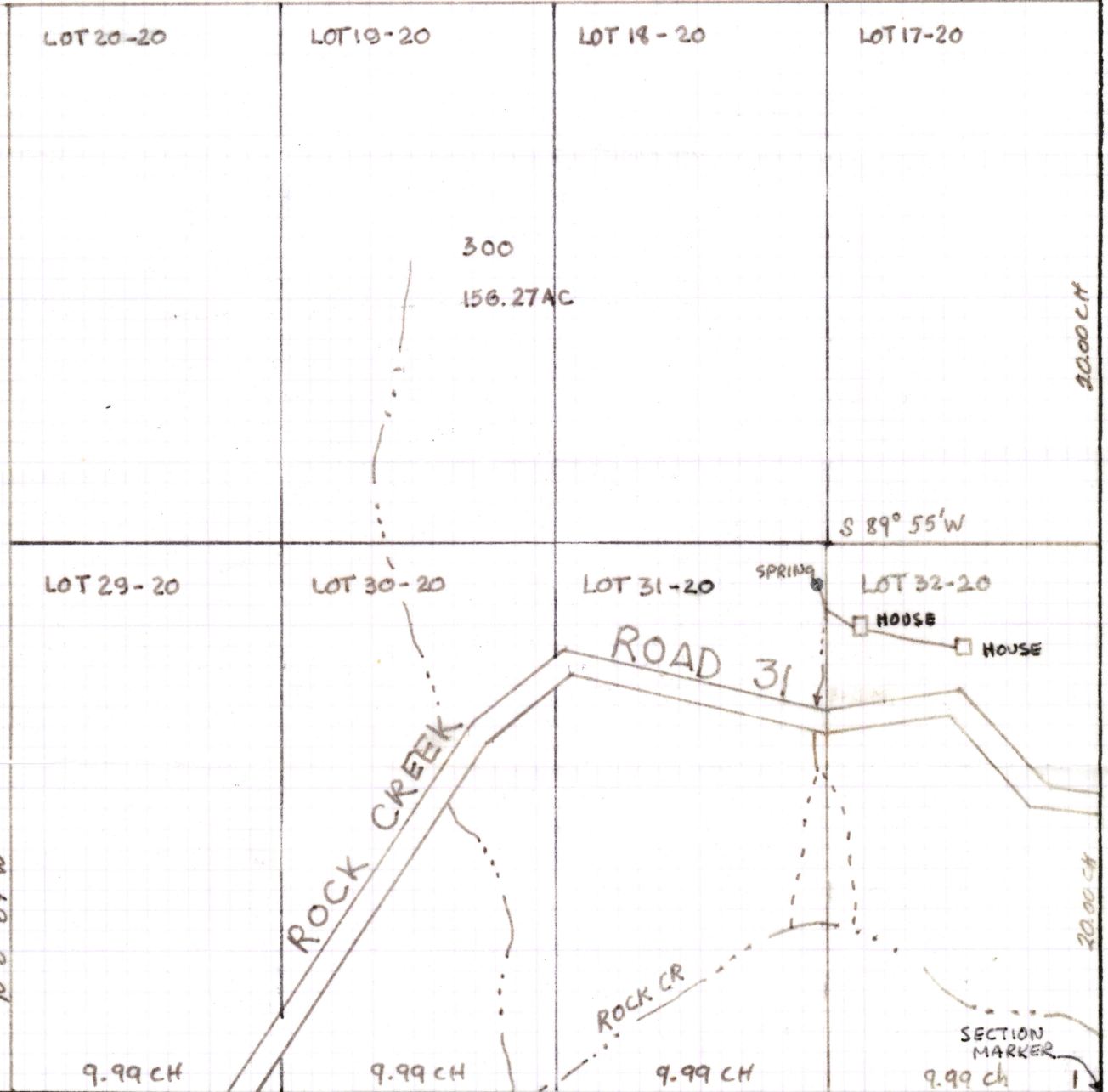

This will acknowledge your springs description sheet, a map, fees of \$15.00 and an application for a permit to appropriate 0.01 cubic foot per second of water from an unnamed stream for domestic supplies for two families. Your application could not be filed because it was not accompanied by the statutory examination fee of \$20.00.

The application, as submitted, requires the \$20.00 examination fee and a permit recording fee of \$15.00 for domestic use. Therefore, total fees of \$35.00 are required.
