Application for a Permit to Construct a Reservoir

I (We) make application for a permit to construct Winter runoff storage reservoir and store the following described waters of the State of Oregon:

1. SOURCE OF WATER for the proposed use: An named seasonal stream, a tributary of Snyder Creek.
If not in channel of a stream, state how it is to be filled: In Channel

2. THE DAM: The maximum height of the structure will be 10' (ten) feet above stream bed or ground surface at the centerline.
The dam will be (check one) earthfill, concrete, flashboard, other.
~~Other~~ give description: Clay core, Clay-silt-sand surfacing, No cracks. Has 5' wide decomposed granite roadway access top center. Top of Dam is 14' wide, outer slope is 1:1 and inside slope 2.5:1. Dam is in good and shows no erosion after 7 years
Give the location, description, and dimensions of the outlet conduit: 18" x 40' Corrograted Metal. Lays parrallel to earthen spillway. Approx 20' from spillway.
(Is Not installed presently - Will install if application approved)

NOTE: All dams across natural stream channels must be provided with an outlet conduit, minimum diameter of 8", or be of such capacity and location as to pass the normal flow of the stream at any time.

3. THE USE(s) of the impounded water will be: 6 acres farm irigation.
A mix of sprinklers and drip.

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4. THE AMOUNT OF WATER to be stored is: 12 (twelve) acre-feet.
The area submerged by the reservoir, when filled, will be 2.5 acres,
and the maximum depth of water will be 12 feet.

5. SPILLWAY DESCRIPTION (location and dimensions). State whether over or around the dam. Around dam on East side of pond. 8' wide x 3' deep.
Rocked with coarse shale - 12" minus
Spillway located in natural, ~~undisturbed~~ undisturbed soil
consisting mainly of red clay.

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REMARKS: Dam and Pond were constructed in Mid to Late 1980's. Owner was unaware of the need to acquire permits. Water in the pond has been in use steadily since 1988. Main use of water is Blueberry irrigation. This is a small U-pick operation. Dam is 10' high in center, has an 8" pvc sch 40 through center bottom, and 8' wide x 3' deep earthen spillway around East end on native soil. Pond has island in center. Is filled in approx 20 days of streamflow during winter.
Supplied helicopters during fires of 1994. Has attracted much wild life to area.

NOTE: The permit, when issued, is for the beneficial use of water without waste. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and acknowledged plan.
