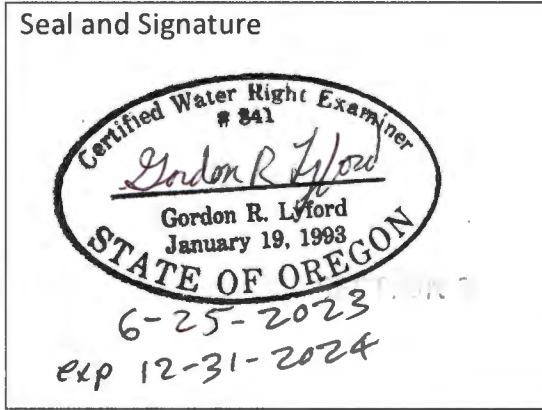

General system description:

As early as 1899 the Wing-Farren ditch was constructed to divert water from Rough and Ready Creek for irrigation uses. In 2001 the open ditch was replaced with a buried PVC pipeline placed in the ditch prism. Water is diverted through a headgate with a low rock pushup dam into an 18-inch diameter PVC pipe into an ODFW constructed a solar powered fish screen 150 feet below the headgate. There is a 6-inch diameter PVC fishway that returns to the creek. An 18-inche diameter PVC pipe leaves the fish screen and transitions into a 15-inch diameter PVC pipe. Past Piddle Creek the PVC pipeline is 10 inches in diameter. The Wing-Farren pipeline serves several water users.

For T-13590 water is re-diverted from the 10-inch PVC pipeline at a takeout with a 2 HP variable speed Goulds centrifugal pump into a 1.25-inch buried PVC pipeline through a 1.5-inch Netafim water meter to the place of use. Various sprinklers are used to irrigate the 2.0 acres of landscape, garden, and pastures including impact sprinklers and popup sprinklers. Two 2500-gallon water tanks store water that is moved by a 1 HP Goulds centrifugal pump to irrigate the landscape around the house. The landscape includes three zones and 9 Hunter popup sprinklers and hand watering faucets. The two pastures include 3 impact sprinklers that are moved around. The garden includes many drip emitters. A field inspection found that the 3 impact sprinklers, each with 5-mm nozzles, had an average operating pressure of 44 psi. The metered flow was 19.5 gpm or 0.043 cfs.

A headgate was required and is installed. The ODFW installed a solar powered rotating drum fish screen with a return fishway 150 feet after the headgate. These are at the head of the Wing-Farren pipeline on Rough and Ready Creek which serves several water right users. See the T-13590 application map for the POD headgate and fish screen locations.
