# EASEMENT FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES $\gamma$ $\gamma$ $\gamma$

Al and Karen Grandpre, herein collectively called "Declarants", for themselves, their heirs, personal representatives, successors, grantees and assigns, make and execute this easement for access, ingress and egress, replacement and maintenance of pump, pipe, wire and electrical service for irrigation purposes on the date set forth below.

Declarants are the owners of real property referred to as Township 40 South, Range 3 West, Section 18D Tax Lot 200, currently with the address of 12780 Applegate Road, in Jackson County, Oregon, hereafter referred to as "TL200", and more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated by this reference herein.

Declarants are the owners of real property referred to as Township 40 South, Range 3 West, Section 18D, Tax Lot 100, in Jackson County, Oregon, hereafter referred to as "TL100", and more particularly described in Exhibit "B" attached hereto and incorporated by this reference herein.

Whereas, the Declarants contemplate selling one or both of said parcels and wish to provide for the continuing use of an irrigation water supply system on TL200 for the benefit of TL100;

Now, therefore, Declarants hereby grant and convey a perpetual, nonexclusive easement over and across TL 200 for the benefit of TL 100 for ingress, egress, and access to, and for the location, use, maintenance, repair, replacement, upkeep and improvement of an existing irrigation system currently installed on or in TL 200. The existing irrigation system consists generally of buried pressure pipe, electrical wire from the pump location to the top of the high bank, electrical service and controls, and above ground pressure pipe and related fittings, as well as a location for an irrigation pump and hard suction with foot valve at the point of diversion in the Applegate river, the said pump, suction and foot value having traditionally been placed and removed annually on a seasonal basis.

1 - EASEMENT FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES

AMONITITIE WAS REQUESTED TO RECORD THIS INSTRUMENT AS AN ACCOMMODATION. IT HAS NOT BEEN EXAMINED FOR SUFFICIENCY OR ITS EFFECT UPON THE TITLE.

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The Easement granted herein is described as encompassing an area 10 feet on either side on the existing buried pressure line, electrical service, above ground pressure line, electrical wiring and fittings up the high bank, the pump pad area just above the river high water mark, and the suction area.

The Easement includes the right of ingress and egress over and across the existing driveway on TL 200 for access to excavate and repair or replace the existing buried pressure pipe, the existing electrical service and pump controls, and the pressure line and wire and fittings currently installed on the riverbank between the electrical service and the river, as well as the pump pad area just over the river high water mark, and for access to the Applegate river for installation, maintenance, and removal of the irrigation pump and suction line and for the creation and maintenance of the suction area within the river bed for purposes of drawing irrigation water at the point of diversion.

The Easement granted herein also includes the right of ingress and egress, along existing roads or driveways on TL 200 where practicable, for access to and the use of the River Access Ford at the northerly end of TL 200 for equipment access to the river for pump and suction pipe placement, maintenance, repair, and removal, and for diversion point maintenance as needed, subject to the condition that the current owner of TL 100 give seven (7) days written notice to the owner of TL 200 prior to using or crossing the said River Access Ford.

Any excavation work within the area on TL 200 encompassed by this Easement is subject to the following conditions:

1. No such excavation work shall commence without seven (7) calendar days prior written notice by the owner of TL 100 to the owner of TL 200.

2. Any such excavation work shall not interfere in any way with the irrigation system serving TL 200 without the prior written approval of the owner of TL 200, which prior written approval may not be unreasonably

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3. Any such excavation must be repaired and filled and the land restored to its original pre-excavation condition, within fifteen (15) days of the inception of excavation, unless other arrangements have been agreed to in a writing signed by the owner of TL 100 and the owner of TL 200.

4. Declarants disclose that there is another existing irrigation system in place on TL 200 for the benefit of TL 200 ("the TL 200 irrigation system") and the Easement granted herein is specifically restricted to such use and activity which does not interfere with or injure in any way the TL 200 irrigation system, unless prior arrangements are agreed to in writing signed by the owner of TL 100 and the owner of TL 200.

The Easement granted herein is intended to run with the lands, subject to the terms and conditions set forth herein, with TL 100 as the dominant estate and TL 200 as the servient estate.
