#### Water-Use Permit Application Processing

#### 1. Completeness Determination

SALEM, OR

The Department evaluates whether the application and accompanying map contain all of the information required under OAR 690-310-0040 and OAR 690-310-0050 (<u>www.oregon.gov/owrd/law.oar</u>). The Department also determines whether the proposed use is prohibited by statute. If the Department determines that the application is incomplete, all fees have not been paid, or the use is prohibited by statute, the application and all fees submitted are returned to the applicant.

#### 2. Initial Review

The Department reviews the application to determine whether water is available during the period requested, whether the proposed use is restricted or limited by rule or statute, and whether other issues may preclude approval of or restrict the proposed use. An Initial Review (IR) containing preliminary determinations is mailed to the applicant. The applicant has 14 days from the mailing date to withdraw the application from further processing and receive a refund of all fees paid minus \$200. The applicant may put the application on hold for up to 180 days and may request additional time if necessary.

#### **3. Public Notice**

Within 7 days of the mailing of the initial review, the Department gives public notice of the application in the weekly notice published by the Department at <u>www.oregon.gov/owrd</u>. The public comment period is 30 days from publication in the weekly notice.

#### 4. Proposed Final Order Issued

The Department reviews any comments received, including comments from other state agencies related to the protection of sensitive, threatened or endangered fish species. Within 60 days of completion of the IR, the Department issues a Proposed Final Order (PFO) explaining the proposed decision to deny or approve the application. A PFO proposing approval of an application will include a draft permit, and may request additional information or outstanding fees required prior to permit issuance.

#### 5. Public Notice

Within 7 days of issuing the PFO, the Department gives public notice in the weekly notice. Notice includes information about the application and the PFO. Protest must be received by the Department within 45 days after publication of the PFO in the weekly notice. Anyone may file a protest. The protest filing fee is \$350.00 for the applicant and \$700.00 for non-applicants. Protests are filed on approximately 10% of Proposed Final Orders. If a protest is filed the Department will attempt to settle the protest but will schedule a contested case hearing if necessary.

#### 6. Final Order Issued

If no protests are filed, the Department can issue a Final Order within 60 days of the close of the period for receiving protest. If the application is approved, a permit is issued. The permit specifies the details of the authorized use and any terms, limitations or conditions that the Department deems appropriate.

<u>A submersible pump with a fish screen on the intake is expected to be seasonally installed on a dock planned for the river. The motor controls are expected to be installed on the riverbank at a height sufficient to protect the equipment from floods. A buried mainline will extend from the dock to the</u>

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places of use. The portion of the pipeline underlying Eilers Road will be bored to limit disturbance to the roadway.

The amount of water requested is a small portion of the total river flow, and the release of water from storage is expected to benefit the river reaches between the reservoirs and the proposed point of diversion.



I represent Phil Fogg, owner of property in Clackamas County, located at 15905 NE Eilers Road, Aurora, OR 97002. With the assistance of CWRE Steve Bruce, Skookum Water Associates, Inc., Mr. Fogg and I have prepared the following for submission to the Department:

#### Application for a Permit to Store Water in a Reservoir (Alternate Review)

Mr. Fogg (through his agent, Mark Rosenkranz) originally submitted this application in October 2015. In a letter dated October 22, 2015, the Department returned the application as incomplete. I have included a copy of the Department's letter. This resubmission is identical to the first, except that we have (1) changed the agent information and the source (to include runoff) on page 1, (2) substituted a new Land Use Compatibility Statement, and (3) enclosed a copy of Mr. Fogg's deed to the property, which includes a property description. We also enclose Mr. Fogg's original check in the amount of \$830.

#### Application for a Permit to Use Surface Water

We are also submitting a permit application for surface water, for irrigation on the same property. This application includes a signed Land Use Compatibility Statement, a copy of Mr. Fogg's deed to the property, a copy of the Contract Data Sheet provided to the United States Bureau of Reclamation, and a check for \$1850.
