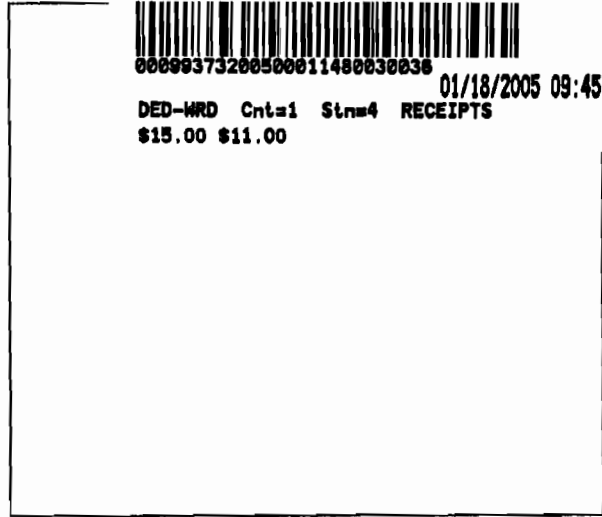

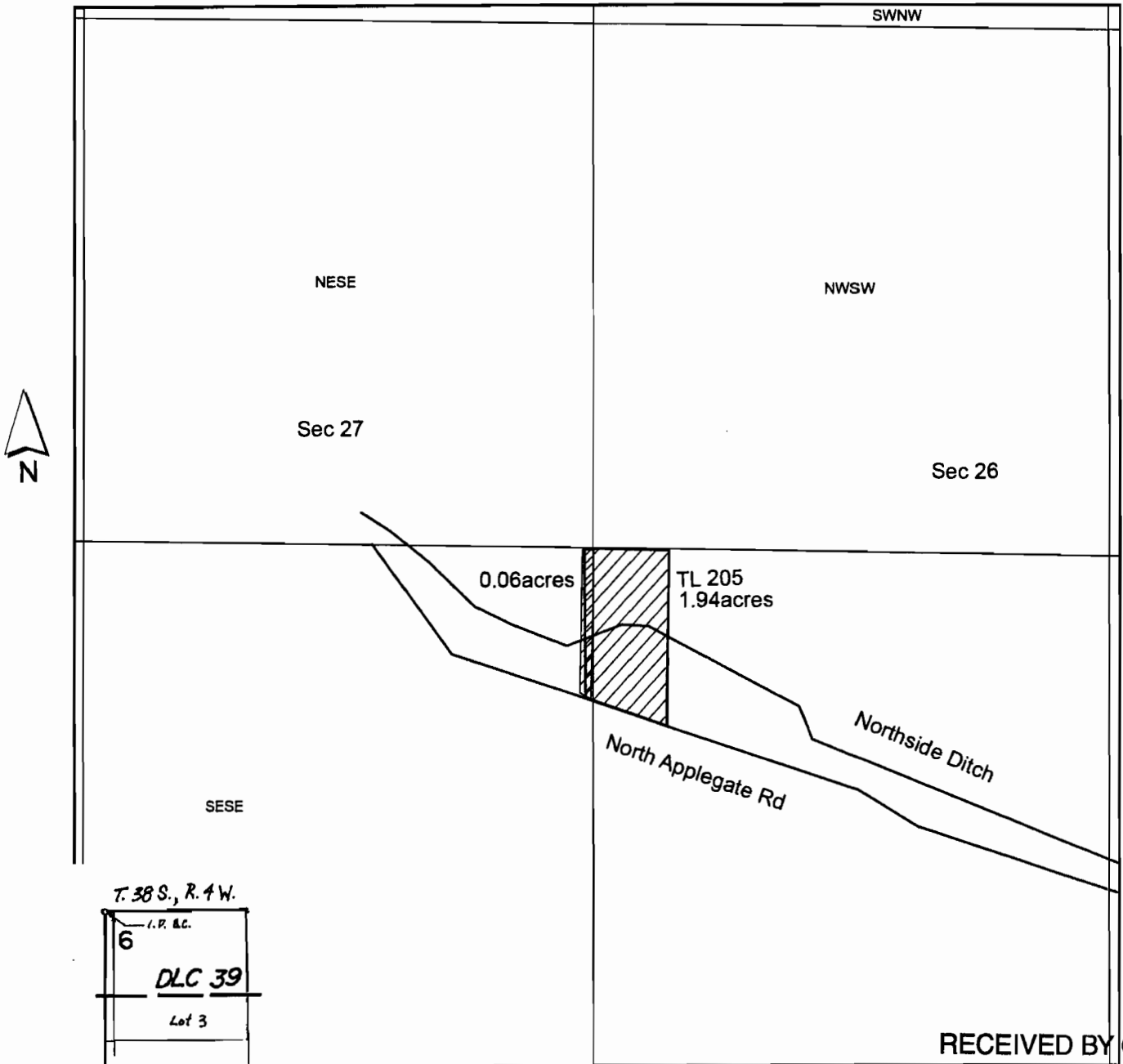

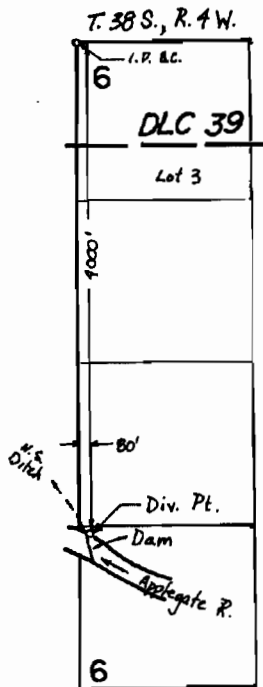

  - b) The application involves a change in place of use only;
