#### 1. Completeness Determination

The Department evaluates whether the application and accompanying map contain all of the information required under OAR 690-310-0040 and OAR 690-310-0050 (www.oregon.gov/owrd/law.oar). The Department also determines whether the proposed use is prohibited by statute. If the Department determines that the application is incomplete, all fees have not been paid, or the use is prohibited by statute, the application and all fees submitted are returned to the applicant.

#### 2. Initial Review

The Department reviews the application to determine whether water is available during the period requested, whether the proposed use is restricted or limited by rule or statute, and whether other issues may preclude approval of or restrict the proposed use. An Initial Review (IR) containing preliminary determinations is mailed to the applicant. The applicant has 14 days from the mailing date to withdraw the application from further processing and receive a refund of all fees paid minus \$200. The applicant may put the application on hold for up to 180 days and may request additional time if necessary.

#### 3. Public Notice

Within 7 days of the mailing of the initial review, the Department gives public notice of the application in the weekly notice published by the Department at www.oregon.gov/owrd. The public comment period is 30 days from publication in the weekly notice.

#### 4. Proposed Final Order Issued

The Department reviews any comments received, including comments from other state agencies related to the protection of sensitive, threatened or endangered fish species. Within 60 days of completion of the IR, the Department issues a Proposed Final Order (PFO) explaining the proposed decision to deny or approve the application. A PFO proposing approval of an application will include a draft permit, and may request additional information or outstanding fees required prior to permit issuance.

#### 5. Public Notice

Within 7 days of issuing the PFO, the Department gives public notice in the weekly notice. Notice includes information about the application and the PFO. Protest must be received by the Department within 45 days after publication of the PFO in the weekly notice. Anyone may file a protest. The protest filing fee is \$350.00 for the applicant and \$700.00 for non-applicants. Protests are filed on approximately 10% of Proposed Final Orders. If a protest is filed the Department will attempt to settle the protest but will schedule a contested case hearing if necessary.

#### 6. Final Order Issued

If no protests are filed, the Department can issue a Final Order within 60 days of the close of the period for receiving protest. If the application is approved, a permit is issued. The permit specifies the details of the authorized use and any terms, limitations or conditions that the Department deems appropriate.

A 2 hp submersible pump will be installed in the Rogue River each spring at the beginning of the irrigation season. Water will be conveyed via approximately 200 feet of 2" PVC and plastic pipe to the proposed place of use.

#### **B.** Application Method

What equipment and method of application will be used? (e.g., drip, wheel line, high-pressure sprinkler)

Pop-up sprinklers and drip systems will be used to apply the water to the proposed landscape and garden areas. The water will also be used for the initial filling each year and to makeup evaporation losses of the proposed landscape water feature which will have a recirculating system.

#### C. Conservation

Please describe why the amount of water requested is needed and measures you propose to: prevent waste; measure the amount of water diverted; prevent damage to public uses of affected surface waters.

The amount of water requested is the minimum amount of water that will be needed to provide viable maintenance of the plants in the landscaped and garden areas. The sprinklers will be controlled by zoned systems on timers. The timing of the irrigation together with drip systems will allow for a more efficient use of the water and will prevent waste by keeping the water applications confined to the desired places of use.

Construction will be limited to trenching from the house to a point located above the flood plain. An above-ground plastic pipe located in the flood plain will be used to convey water from the submersible pump to a riser at the end of the underground pipe placed in the trench. The pump and above-ground pipe will be removed at the end of each irrigation season.

This application for the use of surface water from Lost Creek Reservoir is being made concurrently with the application for contract water from the Bureau of Reclamation. As per the B.O.R. Contract Data Sheet, the map prepared for this application is also being used for the B.O.R. application. As of this date – there is no contract number.

The project schedule dates shown above are approximate. They are contingent upon the date of issuance of the surface water permit from the Water Resources Department.

The pump site is located within the Scenic Easement of the Rogue River – a national scenic waterway. The construction activity and construction materials will be under the review of the B.L.M. who is in charge of enforcing the conditions of the scenic easement.

Prior water rights exist on this parcel per Certificate No. 31994 which has a priority date of February 8, 1961. This right is for the domestic use of water from two springs that are still being used. However, the final proof survey plat shows a garden that is not mentioned in the certificate. There are times during the irrigation season when the water supply is not adequate for domestic use and irrigation. It is proposed that the contract water from this application will be used for the primary irrigation of this garden as well as the additional landscaped areas.


