SUBJECT: Freeman Farms (Molalla River Misc.)

On Sept. 29, 1980 I spoke with Mr. Wayne Lee, foreman of Freeman Farms. Mr. Lee told me that he has been with Freeman Farms for just over two years.

I asked Mr. Lee what the source of water is for irrigation. He said all the land is irrigated from the ditch that runs through the place in a North Easterly direction. This water is diverted from the unnamed stream (ditch) referred to on the map for application 8235 permit 5340 certificate 6668. The water is run down an open ditch and under the county road (Wiles Rd.) into a concrete catch basin. The water is pumped from there onto the land Northeast of the road. There is an old pond below the concrete catch basin. This pond is dry and appears to have been dry for a number of years. This irrigation includes land in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 34, T4S R2E. There is no irrigated land, from this source in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ or SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 34 T4S R2E. It does not appear that there has ever been any irrigation in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ or SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ on the Freeman place. See photo DFK 3D 159, DFK 3LL 59.

I asked Mr. Lee if any water was used from the unnamed stream which parallels the county road (Wiles Rd) and cuts across the Freeman place just East of the irrigated land in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 34 T4S R2E. He said no water is being used from that unnamed stream.

This is the unnamed stream shown on the map for application 14802 permit 10767 certificate 11713.

There is no way to get water from this stream into their irrigation system. There is in fact at least one farm road across what appears to be an old ditch that could have been used to bring water from this unnamed stream to the old pond below the existing catch basin.

I then asked Mr. Lee if there was any use of water from any of the springs referred to in application 8667 permit 5740 certificate 6676 and application 16249 permit 12147 certificate 11757. He said the springs were not being used. The domestic water and water for the barns comes from a well.

The irrigation system as it is now set up does not allow use of water from any source other than the unnamed stream shown on the map for application 8235 permit 5340 certificate 6668.

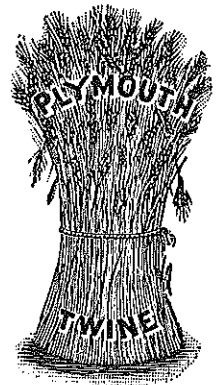
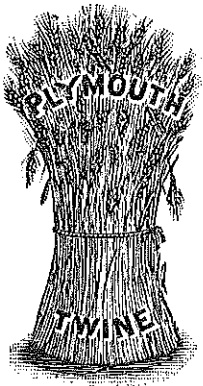

Trusting you will have no difficulty in this matter, I remain

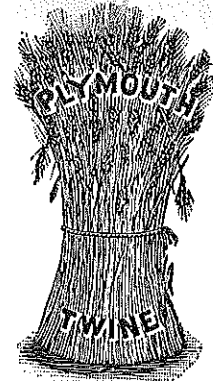
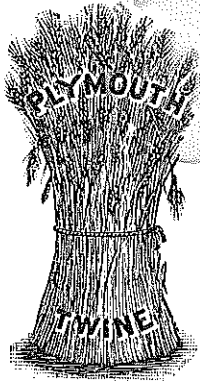

Dear Sirs:-

I am in receipt of your letter of December 14th transmitting your application No. 8667. I am also in receipt of map. I am again returning the application and map for correction.

Under Question No. 4, the point of diversion should be located within a 40-acre tract. It would appear from the map that the point of diversion from the spring is within the NE SW Sec. 35.

You do not show the point of diversion for the irrigation of the 3 acres, but indicate on the map the 3 acres as being located in the SW NW Sec. 35.

Under Question No. 5, the termination of the ditch or pipeline should be given. It would appear from the map that the termination of the pipeline for domestic use is within the NE SW Sec. 35, but this is not shown on the application.

The statement, the SW 40 of the one-fourth Sec. 35, and the NW 40 of one-fourth Sec. 35 is not clear, as there are four quarters to Sec. 35.

You will note under Question 9 the land to be irrigated is given as within the NW SW Sec. 34, while the map indicates the 3 acres within the NE NW Sec. 35. The map and application should correspond in all respects.

In order to retain its original date of priority this application completed and accompanied by the map, should be returned to this office on or before January 14th.

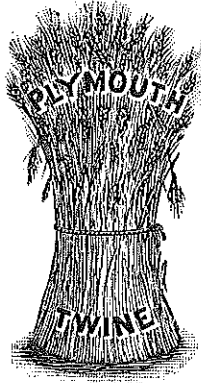

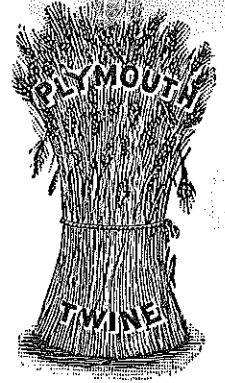

Gentlemen:--

I am in receipt of your letter transmitting Application No. 8667. I am also in receipt of map.

I am again returning application for answers to Questions 4, 5, 12, 13, 14 & 15, and signatures of applicant and witnesses.

Under Question No. 4, the point of diversion within a 40-acre tract should be set forth, and under Question No. 5 the termination of the ditch should be given within a 40-acre tract.

You should indicate on the map the point of diversion the location of the ditch or pipeline and the number of acres to be irrigated within each 40-acre tract. You should also indicate on the map the place of use for domestic purposes, and the ditch or pipeline from the source of supply to the place of use. The application should be signed and should bear the signatures of applicant and witnesses.

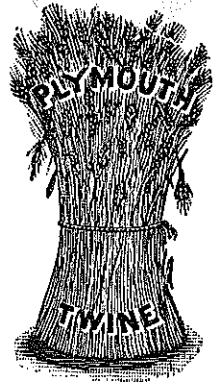
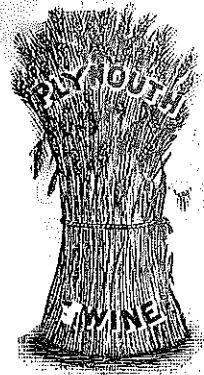
Upon the return of the application and maps properly corrected, the same will be taken up for approval.

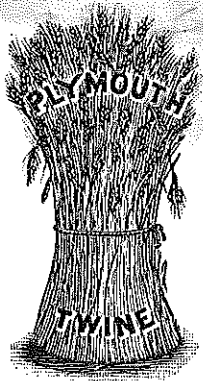

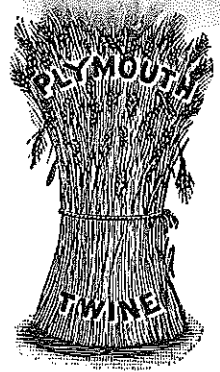

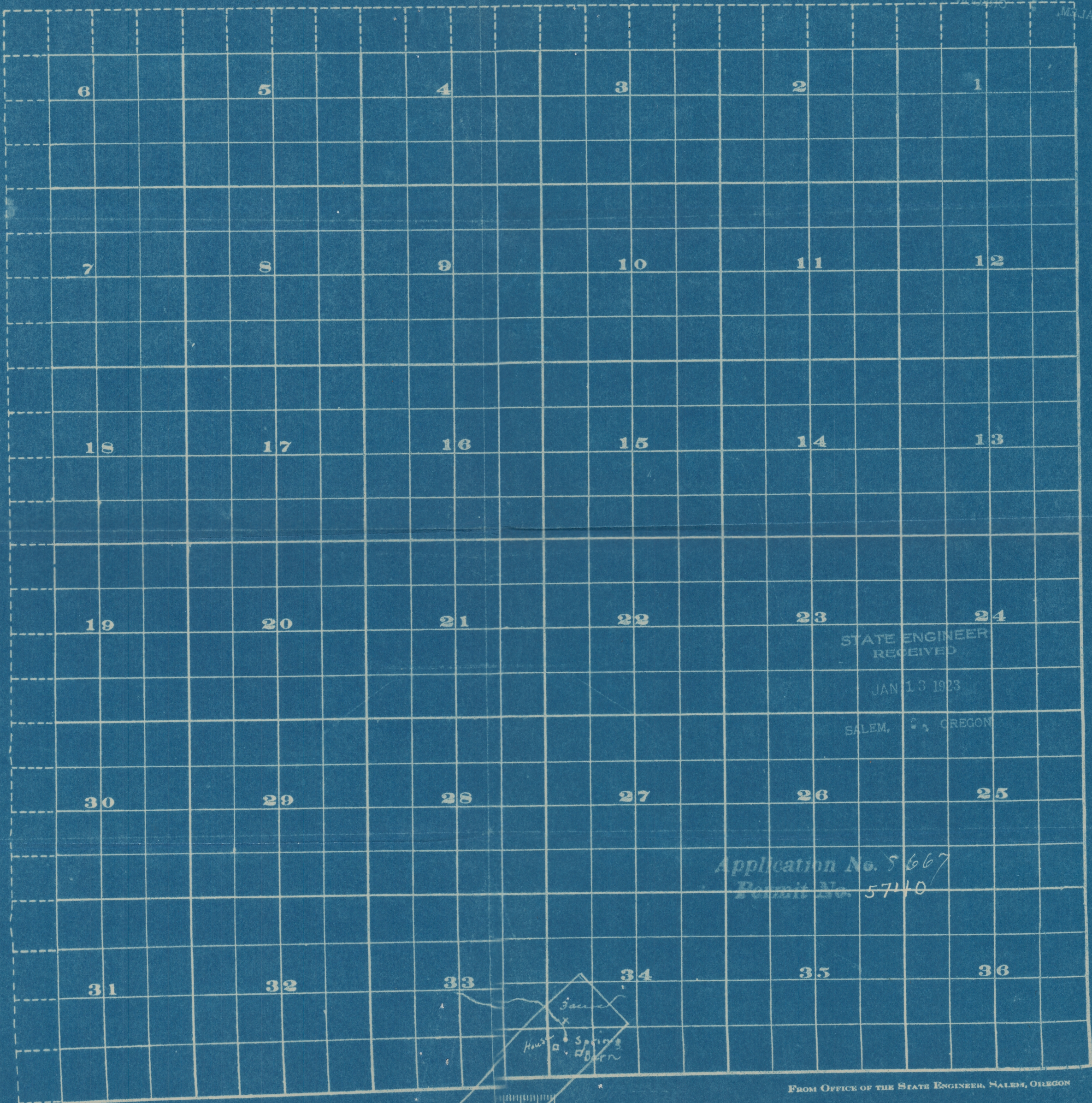
