PROPOSED CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

BOISE CASCADE CORPORATION, TIMBER AND WOOD PRODUCTS GROUP, of P.O. BOX 610, LA GRANDE, OREGON 97850, has a right to the use of the waters of SPRINGS, PROCESS WASTE WATER AND A RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-6481, a tributary of PHILLIPS CREEK, for the purpose of LOG DECK SPRINKLING INCLUDING EVAPORATIVE DISPOSAL.

The right has been perfected under Permit 40678. The date of priority is AUGUST 18, 1976. The right is limited to not more than 3.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 16, T 1 N, R 39 E, W.M.;
SPRINGS AND WASTE WATER - 1300 FEET NORTH & 150 FEET WEST; RESERVOIR-
1100 FEET NORTH & 1300 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE SE CORNER SECTION 16.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

S 1/2 NE 1/4
N 1/2 SE 1/4
SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 1 NORTH, RANGE 39 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The right is subject to minimum flows established by the Water Resources Commission with an effective date prior to this right.

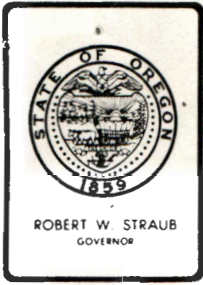

The plans and specifications for the Elgin Mill Wastewater Lagoon have been reviewed and approved. Copies of the approved plans and specifications have been forwarded to Mr. Neal Imeson. Because this structure exceeds the size limits for exempt structures, construction must be supervised by an engineer licensed to practice in the State of Oregon, or by a qualified representative of the Federal Government. Because your office prepared the plans and specifications, I will assume that you will provide the required supervision and inspection. If this is incorrect, please advise me immediately.

Any deviations from the approved plans and specifications will require prior approval from this office. In the event that any deviations become necessary during construction due to unforeseen circumstances, engineers are available from this office to work with you and are authorized to grant immediate approval in the field.

Please advise this office when construction starts so that we may schedule periodic field inspections.

Phone discussion with Neil Imransen Board Cascade authorized change in app to agree with plans dam height 10.5 and ave. depth 8.9. He also authorized adding source to fill as springs and waste water as shown in secondary. In the Secondary app. item 2 should be reduced to 3 cfs. 1 cfs process waste and 2 cfs spring water. The 3.34 was based on maximum instantaneous flush and the pump sump levels this to just under 3 cfs for maximum diversion and a proper limit. Item 4 and 8 complete to agree with map.

Issue permits right away.

Dear Sir:

This letter will inform you of our intention to construct a waste water storage lagoon near our manufacturing facility at Elgin, Oregon. Plans and specifications, by Anderson-Perry and Associates, registered professional engineers, are attached for your approval.

The proposed lagoon will have a holding capacity of 131 acre foot. Maximum water depth will be ten feet. The dike will be 13.5 feet high. The lagoon and dike will cover approximately fifteen acres.

The lagoon will be constructed as part of a waste water control project, designed to eliminate process water discharge into Phillips Creek at Elgin, Oregon. Water will enter the lagoon through a metering station on the north dike and be removed from the lagoon through an outlet 10" pipe and pump system located at the north east corner of the lagoon.

The lagoon will be located approximately within T. 1 N. R. 39 E. W.M. Sec 16 SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ entirely on Boise Cascade Corporation property. The dike will be constructed from native materials found on the site.

No appropriation or storage of public waters are involved in the waste water storage lagoon.

We propose to begin construction of the lagoon by July 1, 1976. Expeditions approval of the attached plans will be appreciated.
