9-A) The project is of a size and scope that was originally planned to be phased in over a time frame longer than the one allowed in the permit.

Because of 9-B (reallocation of financial resources) this project is taking longer to get constructed that was originally anticipated.

9-B) The financial resources needed to develop the project precluded completion of the project within authorized time frames.

Financial resources that were to be used for this project had to be allocated to more urgent needs in other areas of the business operation in 2009.

Contractor was unavailable at times and weather delayed progress when construction was underway.

Extra time is needed to allow needed to complete this project because the change in the overall farm economy changed how we had to prioritize where we spent money. We have requested some extra time trying to anticipate time needed to allow for weather, availability of the contractor and equipment and financial requirements.

We are requesting an extension of time to October 1, 2013 because

- 1) By the time OWRD is able to process this extension request the winter construction season for 2009-2010 will be over.
- 2) <u>2010-2011 construction season would be the first full construction season to work and finish the dam.</u>
- 3) <u>Storage probably will not be able to be done in the 2010-2011 season, so 2011-2012</u> (1/1/2012 to 4/14/2012) would be the first full storage period.
- 4) <u>10/1/2013 is just in case we are not able to fill the reservoir in 2011-2012 storage season</u> this would give the 2012-2013 storage season.

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I am the permit holder, or have authorization from the permit holder, to apply for an extension of time under this permit. I understand that false or misleading statements in this extension application are grounds for OWRD to suspend processing of the request and/or reason to deny the extension.
