

Pursuant to your reports and in line with the general practice of this office, a survey will be made next year for the purpose of checking the amount of water used as described in your Permit No. 14216. After this survey, proof may be made by you and certificate issued covering the actual use of water as found by the inspector and in the meantime, the permit which you hold will be valid and sufficient evidence of your water right.
