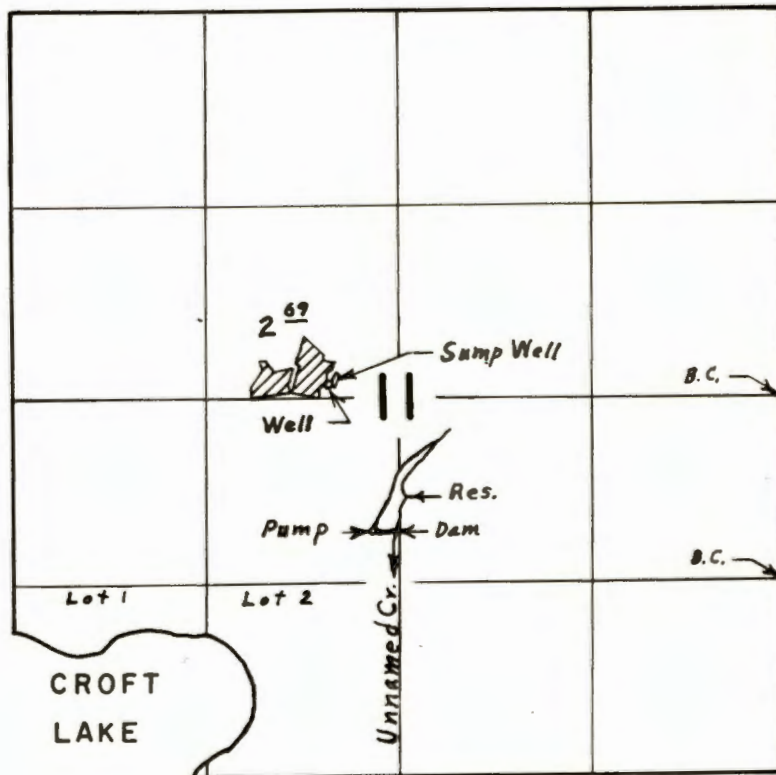



NOTICE TO SELLERS & BUYERS

By law all water belongs to the public [ORS 537.110]. In almost every instance a permit from the Water Resources Department is needed before using, diverting or storing any water [ORS 537.130]. However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A water right stays with the land. In order to keep track of water right ownership, ORS 537.330 requires persons selling property that has water right to: 1) provide evidence of the water right to the buyer and 2) notify the Water Resources Department of the water right involved with the real estate transaction. Sellers are exempted from this requirement if the water uses are served by a water district or a city.

Water that has been used for a long time in one place or that involves a water structure (like a dam) that already exists is no guarantee that there is a water right which would allow the water use to continue.

The Water Resources Department has reviewed and accepted the pump test results you submitted for POD-ID 27828. The Department requires no further testing of this well at this time. However, you will be required to submit a static water level measurement of the well on the ten-year anniversary of the test you conducted.

In regards to POD-ID's 27827, 27826, 27825, they are sump wells (diameter greater than 36 inches and depth less than 30 feet). Such a condition constitutes grounds for a complete exemption for these three.

Our records indicate you have three additional wells on Permit G-6265, in which case, you may qualify for a multiple well exemption if all three of the following criteria are met:

- wells are located within a five-mile radius,
- wells appear to be completed in the same water-bearing zone and
- wells owned by the same landowner.
