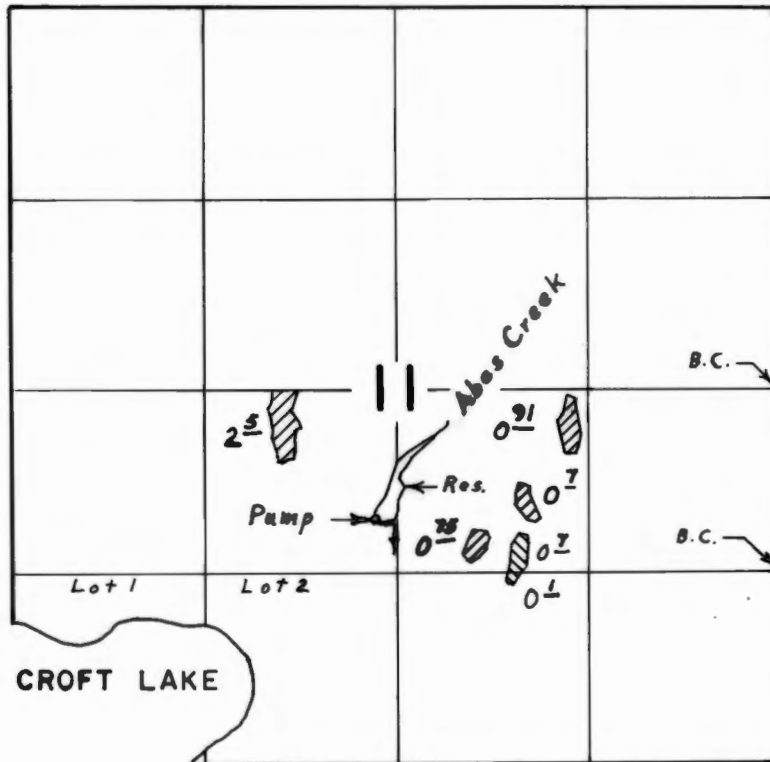



NOTICE TO SELLERS & BUYERS

WATER RESOURCES DEPT.

By law all water belongs to the public [ORS 537.110]. In almost every instance a permit from the Water Resources Department is needed before using, diverting, or storing any water [ORS 537.130]. However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A water right stays with the land. In order to keep track of water right ownership, ORS 537.330 requires persons selling property that has water right to: 1) provide evidence of the water right to the buyer and 2) notify the Water Resources Department of the water right involved with the real estate transaction. Sellers are exempted from this requirement if the water uses are served by a water district or a city.

Water that has been used for a long time in one place or that involves a water structure (like a dam) that already exists is no guarantee that there is a water right which would allow the water use to continue.

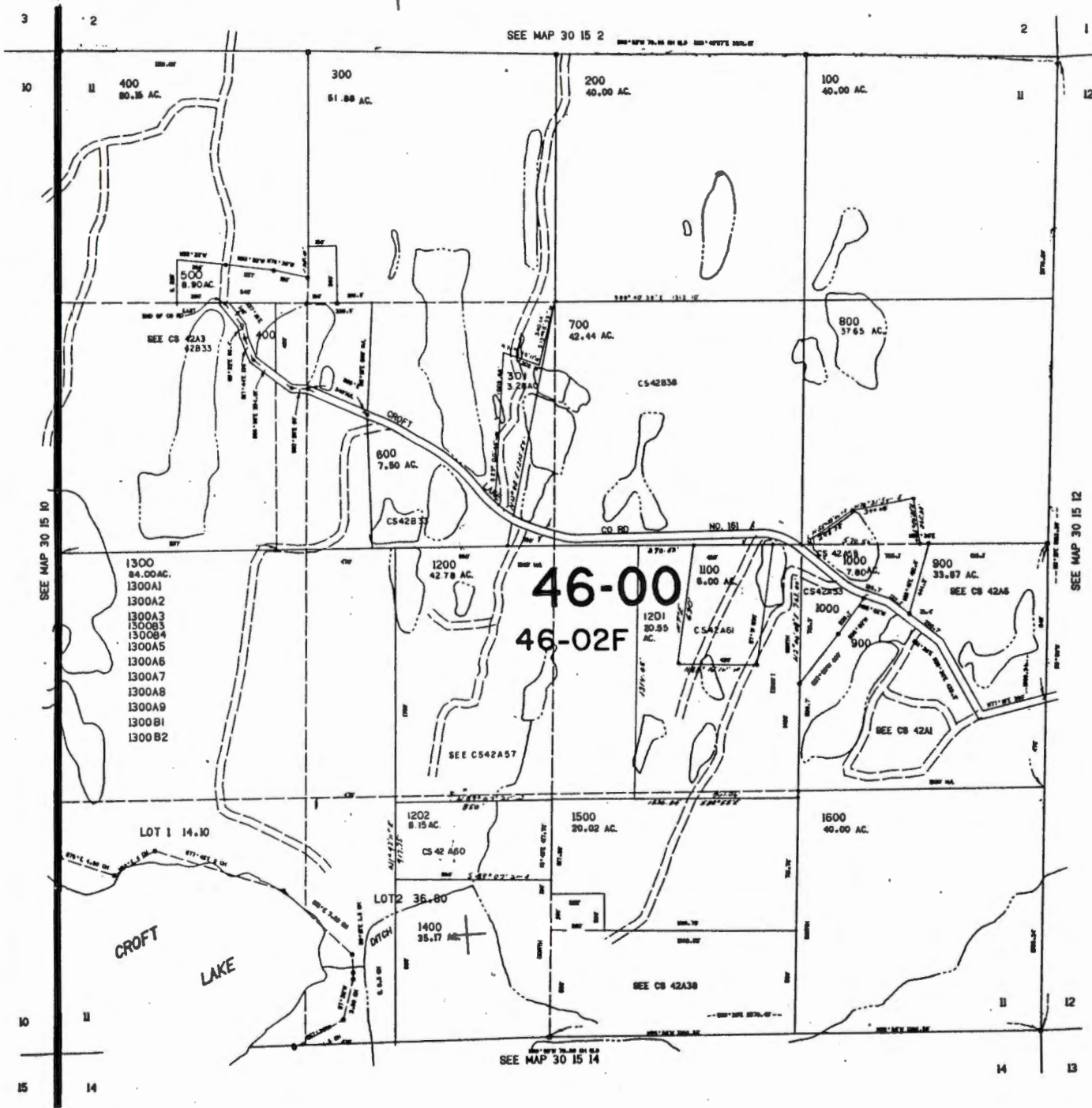

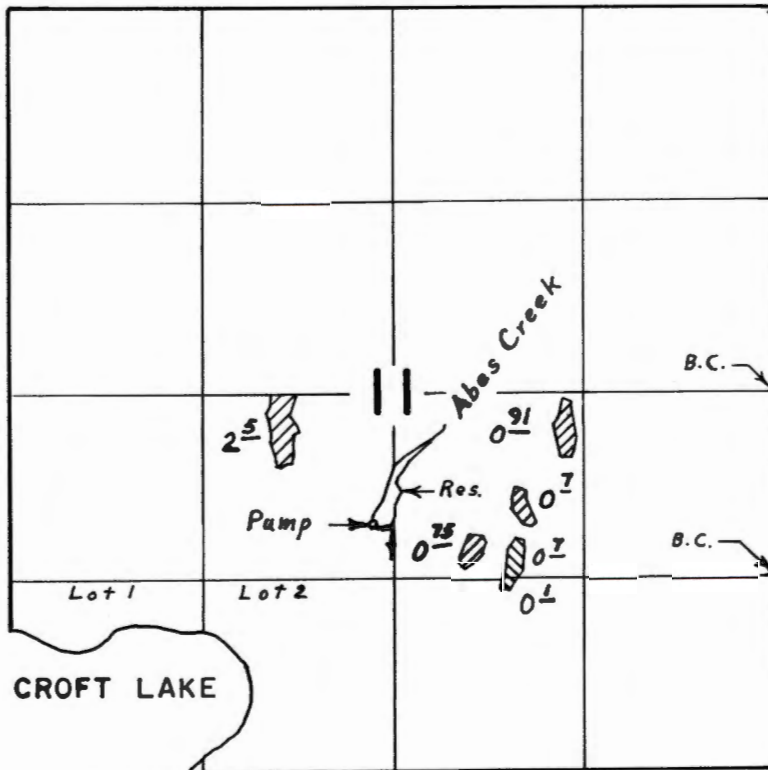

On April 26, 1983, Wayne Foster submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.


The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 50353, Volume 44, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the names of James C. and Marion M. McBee, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second of water from Abe's Creek, with a date of priority of November 25, 1974, being 0.08 cubic foot per second of water for irrigation of 0.70 acre and supplemental irrigation of 2.32 acres, and 0.15 cubic foot per second of water for flood harvesting of 3.02 acres, all within the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 11, Township 30 South, Range 15 West, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 50353, Volume 44, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
