Appeal Rights

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Application History

The Department issued Permit G-12092 on June 20, 1995. The permit called for completion of construction by October 1, 1997 and complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 1998. On August 14, 2007, Doug Femrite dba Femrite Nursery submitted to the Department an Application for Extension of Time for Permit G-12092. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on October 30, 2007, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to complete construction to October 1, 2010 and the time to fully apply water to beneficial use to October 1, 2010. The protest period closed December 14, 2007, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, the permit may be extended subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS

1. <u>Checkpoint Condition</u>

The permit holder must submit a completed Diligence Progress Report to the Department by October 1, 2008. A form is enclosed for your use.

(a) At each checkpoint, the permit holder shall submit and the Department shall review evidence of the permit holder's diligence towards completion of the Final Order: Permit G-12092

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project and compliance with terms and conditions of the permit and extension. If, after this review, the Department determines the permit holder has not been diligent in developing and perfecting the water use permit, or complied with all terms and conditions, the Department shall modify or further condition the permit or extension to ensure future compliance, or begin cancellation proceedings on the undeveloped portion of the permit pursuant to ORS 537.260 or 537.410, or require submission of a final proof survey pursuant to ORS 537.250;

(b) The Department shall provide notice of receipt of progress reports in its weekly notice and shall allow a 30 day comment period for each report. The Department shall provide notice of its determination to anyone who submitted comments.

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.630, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

Order

The extension of time for Application G-12607, Permit G-12092, therefore, is approved subject to conditions contained herein. The deadline for completing construction is extended to October 1, 2010. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use is extended to October 1, 2010.

This Proposed Final Order applies only to Permit G-12092, water right Application G-12607. A copy of Permit G-12092 is enclosed as Attachment 1.

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Summary of Proposed Final Order for Extension of Time

The Department proposes to:

- grant an extension of time for complete construction of the water system from October 1, 1997 to October 1, 2010, and
- grant an extension of time to apply water to full beneficial use from October 1, 1998 to October 1, 2010.
- make the extension subject to certain conditions set forth below.

AUTHORITY

Generally, see ORS 537.630 and OAR Chapter 690 Division 315.

ORS 537.630(1) provide in pertinent part that the Oregon Water Resources Department (Department) may, for good cause shown, order an extension of time within which: irrigation or other works shall be completed; the well or other means of developing and securing ground water shall be completed; or the right perfected. In determining the extension, the Department shall give due weight to the considerations described under ORS 539.010(5) and to whether other governmental requirements relating to the project have significantly delayed completion of construction or perfection of the right.

ORS 539.010(5) provides in pertinent part that the Water Resources Director, for good cause shown, may extend the time within which the full amount of the water appropriated shall be applied to a beneficial use. This statute instructs the Director to consider: the cost of the appropriation and application of the water to a beneficial purpose; the good faith of the appropriator; the market for water or power to be supplied; the present demands therefore; and the income or use that may be required to provide fair and reasonable returns upon the investment.

OAR 690-315-0040 provides in pertinent part that the Water Resources Department shall make findings to determine if an extension of time may be approved to complete construction and/or apply water to full beneficial use.

OAR 690-315-0050(6) requires the Department, for extensions exceeding five years, to establish checkpoints to determine if diligence is being exercised in the development and perfection of the

water use permit. Intervals between checkpoints will not exceed five year periods.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Background

- 1. Permit G-12092 was granted by the Department on June 20, 1995. The permit authorizes the use of up to 0.60 cfs of water from Wells 1 and 2, for nursery operations on 47.0 acres. The permit specified actual construction of the wells was to begin by June 20, 1996, construction of the water system was to be completed by October 1, 1997, and complete application of water was to be made on or before October 1, 1998.
- 2. The permit holder submitted an "Application for Extension of Time" to the Department on August 14, 2007 requesting the time to apply water to full beneficial use under the terms of Permit G-12092 be extended from October 1, 1998 to October 1, 2010. The Application for Extension of Time clearly suggests that construction is not complete. The Department, therefore, determined that the permit holder's intent was to also request the time in which to complete construction of the water system under Permit G-12092 be extended from October 1, 1997 to October 1, 2010. This is the first permit extension requested for Permit G-12092.
- 3. Notification of the Application for Extension of Time for Permit G-12092 was published in the Department's Public Notice dated September 25, 2007. No public comments were received regarding the extension application.

Review Criteria [OAR 690-315-0040]

The time limits to complete construction and/or apply water to full beneficial use may be extended if the Department finds that the permit holder has met the requirements set forth under OAR~690-315-0040. This determination shall consider the applicable requirements of $ORS~537.230^1$, 537.248^2 , 537.630^3 and/or $539.010(5)^4$.

Complete Extension of Time Application [OAR 690-315-0040(1)(a)]

4. On August 14, 2007, the Department received a completed Application for Extension of Time and the fee required by ORS 536.050 from the permit holder.

Start of Construction [OAR 690-315-0040(1)(b) and 690-315-0040(5)]

5. Actual construction of the wells began prior to the deadline specified in the permit, being June 20, 1996.

¹ORS 537.230 applies to surface water permits only.

²ORS 537.248 applies to reservoir permits only.

³ORS 537.630 applies to ground water permits only.

⁴ORS 539.010(5) applies to surface water and ground water permits.

Duration of Extension [OAR 690-315-0040(1)(c)]

Under OAR 690-315-0040(1)(c), in order to approve an extension of time for water use permits the Department must find that the time requested is reasonable and the applicant can complete the project within the time requested.

- 6. As of August 14, 2007, the remaining work to be completed consists of receiving approval of permit amendment T-10442, completing construction of the water system and applying water to full beneficial use.
- 7. Given the amount of development left to occur, the Department has determined that the permit holder's request to have until October 1, 2010, to complete construction of the water system and to accomplish the application of water to beneficial use under the terms of Permit G-12092 is both reasonable and necessary.

Good Cause [OAR 690-315-0040(1)(d)]

The Department's determination of good cause shall consider the requirements set forth under *OAR 690-315-0040(2)*.

Reasonable Diligence of the Appropriator [OAR 690-315-0040(2)(a)]

The Department's determination of reasonable diligence shall consider the requirements set forth under OAR 690-315-0040(3)(a-d). In accordance with OAR 690-315-0040(3), the Department shall consider, but is not limited to, the following factors when determining whether the applicant has demonstrated reasonable diligence in previous performance under the permit:

Amount of Construction [OAR 690-315-0040(3)(a)]

- 8. The following construction was completed within the time allowed in the permit or previous extension:
 - a. Construction of the wells and water system began prior to the time specified in the permit, being June 20, 1996.
 - b. Work was accomplished (specified in the Application for Extension of Time) during the original development time frame under Permit G-12092.

Beneficial Use of Water [OAR 690-315-0040(3)(b)]

- 9. The following beneficial use was made of the water during the permit or previous extension time limits:
 - a. Since the issuance of Permit G-12092 on June 20, 1995, a maximum rate of 0.60 cfs has been appropriated from the wells for nursery operations on 47.0 acres.

Compliance with Conditions [OAR 690-315-0040(3)(c)]

- 10. The water right permit holder's conformance with the permit or previous extension conditions.
 - a. The Department has considered the permit holder's compliance with conditions, and did not identify any concerns.

Financial Investments [OAR 690-315-0040(3)(d)]

- 11. Financial investments made toward developing the beneficial water use.
 - a. As of August 14, 2007, the permit holder has invested approximately \$10,000, which is 83 percent of the total projected cost for complete development of this project. The permit holder anticipates an additional \$2,000 investment is needed for the completion of this project.

Cost to Appropriate and Apply Water to a Beneficial Purpose [OAR 690-315-0040(2)(b)]

12. As of August 14, 2007, the permit holder has invested approximately \$10,000 which is 83 percent of the total projected cost for complete development of this project. The permit holder anticipates an additional \$2,000 investment is needed for the completion of this project.

Good Faith of the Appropriator [OAR 690-315-0040(2)(c)]

13. The Department has found good faith of the appropriator under Permit G-12092.

The Market and Present Demands for Water [OAR 690-315-0040(2)(d-e)]

The Department's determinations of market and present demand for water or power to be supplied shall consider the requirements set forth under OAR 690-315-0040(4)(a-f). In accordance with OAR 690-315-0040(4), the Department shall consider, but is not limited to, the following factors when determining the market and the present demand for water or power to be supplied:

- 14. The amount of water available to satisfy other affected water rights and scenic waterway flows; special water use designations established since permit issuance, including but not limited to state scenic waterways, federal wild and scenic rivers, serious water management problem areas or water quality limited sources established under 33 U.S.C. 1313(d); or the habitat needs of sensitive, threatened or endangered species, in consultation with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife [OAR 690-315-0040(4)(a-c)].
 - a. The amount of water available to satisfy other affected water rights and scenic waterway flows was determined at the time of issuance of Permit G-12092; furthermore, water availability for other affected water rights and scenic waterway flows after the permit was issued is determined at such time that such application for a new water right is submitted. The points of appropriation for Permit G-12092, located within the Willamette River Basin, are not located within a limited or critical ground water area. Willamette River is not located within or above any state or federal scenic waterway, however it is located within an area ranked "low" for stream flow restoration needs as determined by the Department in consultation with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife, and is located within a Sensitive, Threatened or Endangered Fish Species Area as identified by the Department in consultation with Oregon Department of Fish and

Wildlife. Willamette River is listed by the Department of Environmental Quality as a water quality limited stream.

- 15. Economic investment in the project to date [OAR 690-315-0040(4)(d)].
 - a. As of August 14, 2007, the permit holder has invested approximately \$10,000.
- 16. Other economic interests dependent on completion of the project [OAR 690-315-0040(4)(e)].
 - a. None have been identified.
- 17. Other factors relevant to the determination of the market and present demand for water and power [OAR 690-315-0040(4)(f)].
 - a. None have been identified.
- 18. OAR 690-315-0050(6) requires the Department to place a checkpoint condition on this extension of time to ensure diligence is exercised in the development and perfection of the water use permit. A "Checkpoint Condition" is specified under Item 1 of the "Conditions" section of this PFO to meet this condition.

Fair Return Upon Investment [OAR 690-315-0040(2)(f)]

19. Use and income from the permitted water development results in reasonable returns upon the investment made to date.

Other Governmental Requirements [OAR 690-315-0040(2)(g)]

20. Delay in the development of this project was not caused by any other governmental requirements.

Unforeseen Events [OAR 690-315-0040(2)(h)]

21. None have been identified.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The applicant is entitled to apply for an extension of time to complete construction and/or completely apply water to the full beneficial use pursuant to ORS 537.630(1).
- 2. The applicant has submitted a complete extension application form and the fee specified in ORS 536.050, as required by OAR 690-315-0040(1)(a).
- 3. The applicant complied with begin actual construction timeline requirements pursuant to ORS 537.630 as required by OAR 690-315-0040(1)(b) and OAR 690-315-0040(5).
- 4. Completion of construction and full application of water to beneficial use can be

accomplished by October 1, 2010⁵, as required by OAR 690-315-0040(1)(c).

- 5. The Department has considered the reasonable diligence and good faith of the appropriator, the cost to appropriate and apply water to a beneficial purpose, the market and present demands for water to be supplied, the financial investment made and fair and reasonable return upon the investment, the requirements of other governmental agencies, and unforeseen events over which the permit holder had no control, whether denial of the extension will result in undue hardship to the applicant and whether there are no other reasonable alternatives for meeting water use needs, any other factors relevant to a determination of good cause, and has determined that the applicant has shown that good cause exists for an extension of time to apply water to full beneficial use pursuant to OAR 690-315-0040(1)(d).
- 6. As required by OAR 690-315-0050(6) and as described in Finding 18 above, the Department has established, as specified in the "Conditions" section of this PFO (Item 1), progress checkpoints in order to ensure future diligence is exercised in the development and perfection of Permit G-12092.

Proposed Order

Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the Department proposes to issue an order to:

extend the time for complete construction of the water system under Permit G-12092 from October 1, 1997 to October 1, 2010.

extend the time to apply water to beneficial use under Permit G-12092 from October 1, 1998 to October 1, 2010.

Subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS

1. Checkpoint Condition

The permit holder must submit a completed Diligence Progress Report to the Department by October 1, 2008. A form will be enclosed with your Final Order.

(a) At each checkpoint, the permit holder shall submit and the Department shall review evidence of the permit holder's diligence towards completion of the project and compliance with terms and conditions of the permit and extension. If, after this review, the Department determines the permit holder has not been

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diligent in developing and perfecting the water use permit, or complied with all terms and conditions, the Department shall modify or further condition the permit or extension to ensure future compliance, or begin cancellation proceedings on the undeveloped portion of the permit pursuant to ORS 537.260 or 537.410, or require submission of a final proof survey pursuant to ORS 537.250;

(b) The Department shall provide notice of receipt of progress reports in its weekly notice and shall allow a 30 day comment period for each report. The Department shall provide notice of its determination to anyone who submitted comments.

- 2. A written request for contested case hearing shall include:

 - b. A description of the petitioner's interest in the proposed final order and if the protestant claims to represent the public interest, a precise statement of the public interest represented;
 - c. A detailed description of how the action proposed in the proposed final order would adversely affect or aggrieve the petitioner's interest;
 - d. A detailed description of how the final order is in error or deficient and how to correct the alleged error or deficiency;
 - e. Any citation of legal authority supporting the petitioner, if known;
 - f. Proof of service of the protest upon the water right permit holder, if petitioner is other than the water right permit holder; and
 - g. The protest fee required under ORS 536.050, if petitioner is other than the water right permit holder.

- 3. Within 60 days after the close of the period for requesting a contested case hearing, the Director shall:
 - a. Issue a final order on the extension request; or
 - b. Schedule a contested case hearing if a request for contested case hearing has been submitted, and:
 - 1) Upon review of the issues, the Director finds there are significant disputes related to the proposed agency action; or
 - 2) The applicant submits a written request for a contested case hearing within 30 days after the close of the period for submitting protests.

On August 14, 2007, the Department received your Application for Extension of Time for Permit #G-12092, along with a check in the amount of \$350.
