Please release the Administrative Hold on Application #G-15069 and expedite processing of the application. (Marc Norton via watermaster Larry Toll approves of this request.)

Request for Condition

As addressed in earlier correspondence, Applicants request that former condition #8 of the stipulated agreement for #G-14299 (the same well as addressed in Application #G-15069) be included in the draft permit for #G-15069. The requested condition reads as follows:

In the interest of addressing the Department's determination that well #1 (WASC 2717) is hydraulically connected to Eightmile Creek, the supplemental portion of this water right may be exercised even though water is available from the primary source.

Please note that the use of well #2(WASC 50312) in lieu of well #1 (WASC 2717) may minimize any potential impact on nearby surface water and thus better protect wildlife.
