After passing through flowmeters at each well, the water will be conveyed to the place of use via a mainline. Construction disturbances will be limited because the land is already farmed. Water will be applied at agronomic rates.

Water will be applied using a pivot, wheel lines and/or high-pressure sprinklers.

C. Conservation

Please describe why the amount of water requested is needed and measures you propose to: prevent waste; measure the amount of water diverted; prevent damage to aquatic life and riparian habitat; prevent the discharge of contaminated water to a surface stream; prevent adverse impact to public uses of affected surface waters (*attach additional sheets if necessary*).

The amount of water being requested is consistent with other water rights in the Willamette basin. The rate will be 1/80th cfs/acre and the duty will be 2.5 AF/acre. A totalizing flowmeter will be installed at each well to measure the amount of water being pumped. Water will be applied at agronomic rates. In addition, the seasonal drainage that crosses the site is seasonal and dries up; therefore, no discharges to this water body will occur because it is dry when irrigation is needed.

The Department's online water-level measurements and hydrograph for well LINN 51015 indicate groundwater levels have remained stable from March 1998 to March 2020. This well, located in the NE SE of Section 5, Township 12S, Range 3 W, WM., is approximately ¼ mile east of the wells proposed under this application.

The unnamed seasonal drainage that crosses our property only conveys water during the winter and is part of the drainage network that allows farming of the low-lying valley floor that exists in this area.

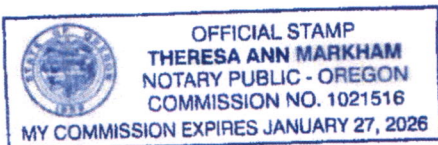

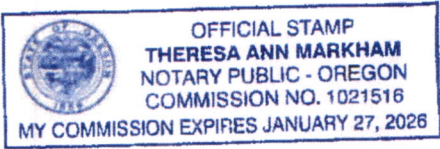
