The amount of water being requested is consistent with other water rights in the Willamette basin. The rate will be 1/80<sup>th</sup> cfs/acre and the duty will be 2.5 AF/acre. A totalizing flowmeter will be installed at each well to measure the amount of water being pumped. Water will be applied at agronomic rates. In addition, the seasonal drainage that crosses the site is seasonal and dries up; therefore, no discharges to this water body will occur because it is dry when irrigation is needed.

The unnamed seasonal drainage that crosses our property only conveys water during the winter and is part of the drainage network that allows farming of the low-lying valley floor that exists in this area.
