

#### Dear Sir:

This will acknowledge receipt of your notice to the effect that complete application of water has been made under Permit No. 0-817.

Pursuant to your report and in line with the general practice of this office, a survey will be made at a later date. After this survey, proof may be made and certificate issued covering the actual use of water as found by the engineer. 


