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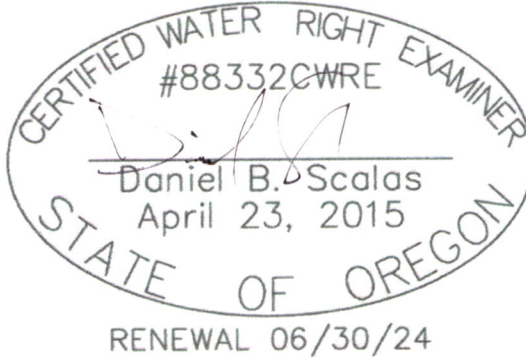

Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 380 implement the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

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Findings of Fact

1. On July 24, 2020, Michael Moore filed an application to change the points of appropriation under Certificates 31787 and 37578. The Department assigned the application number T-13501.
2. Notice of the application for transfer was published on August 11, 2020, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
3. Transfer Application T- 13501 proposes to transfer water rights within the boundaries of Klamath Irrigation District (District). The transfer proposes to transfer lands that are layered with portions of Klamath Project Consolidated Claim 321-17/293/323-3¹ (a.k.a. KA-1000). The claim is not involved in this transfer. On June 15, 2020, the District certified that they consented to the applicant's proposed water right transfer application and maps.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

4. On November 7, 2020, the Department mailed a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-13501 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of December 7, 2020, for the applicant to respond.
5. On November 23, 2020, the applicant contacted the Department, requesting an extension for the draft Preliminary Determination response.
6. On November 24, 2020, the Department extended the draft Preliminary Determination response date to January 5, 2021.
7. On December 23, 2020, the applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer.
8. On March 5, 2021, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer T-13501 and mailed a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on March 9, 2021, and in the Klamath Herald and News newspaper on March 12 and 19, 2021, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.
9. The portion of the first right to be transferred is as follows:

12. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
13. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-13501.
14. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
15. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.
16. All other application requirements are met.

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Conclusions of Law


The change in points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-13501 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. If Transfer Application T-13501 is approved, the final order will include the following:
2. The change in points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-13501 are approved.
3. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 31787 and 37578 and any related decree.
4. Water right Certificates 31787 and 37578 are cancelled. New certificates will be issued describing those portions of the rights not affected by this transfer.
5. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation, (Proposed POA), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation, (Well 1).
6. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of appropriation, (new and existing).
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

7. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
8. Full beneficial use of the water shall be made, consistent with the terms of this order, on or before **October 1, 2022**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the change and full beneficial use of the water.
9. After satisfactory proof of beneficial use is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.

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Authority

Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 690-380-5140(2) authorizes the Department to grant an extension of time to complete a transfer.

OAR 690-380-6020 establishes an application process and criteria for the review of extensions of time to complete a transfer as authorized by a final order issued under OAR Division 380.

OAR 690-380-6020 (3) establishes that extensions are granted for one year, from October 1 to October 1 of each year. Extensions may be granted for longer time if the applicant can justify the need for a longer period of time by submission of pertinent evidence.

Findings of Fact

1. On September 26, 2022, the Department received an application for extension of time for Transfer Application T-13501.
2. On May 18, 2021, the Department signed an order, which was mailed on May 19, 2021, approving Transfer Application T-13501 to change a point of appropriation. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 120, Pages 610-614. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2022.
3. Since the approval of the transfer, the applicant has drilled and cased the new well.
4. To fully complete the change, the applicant needs to purchase a pump and wiring to power the drilled and cased well, and install a totalizing flow meter.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

5. The applicant has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2023. Consistent with OAR 690-380-6020(3), the Department will extend the transfer completion date to October 1, 2024.


Conclusions of Law

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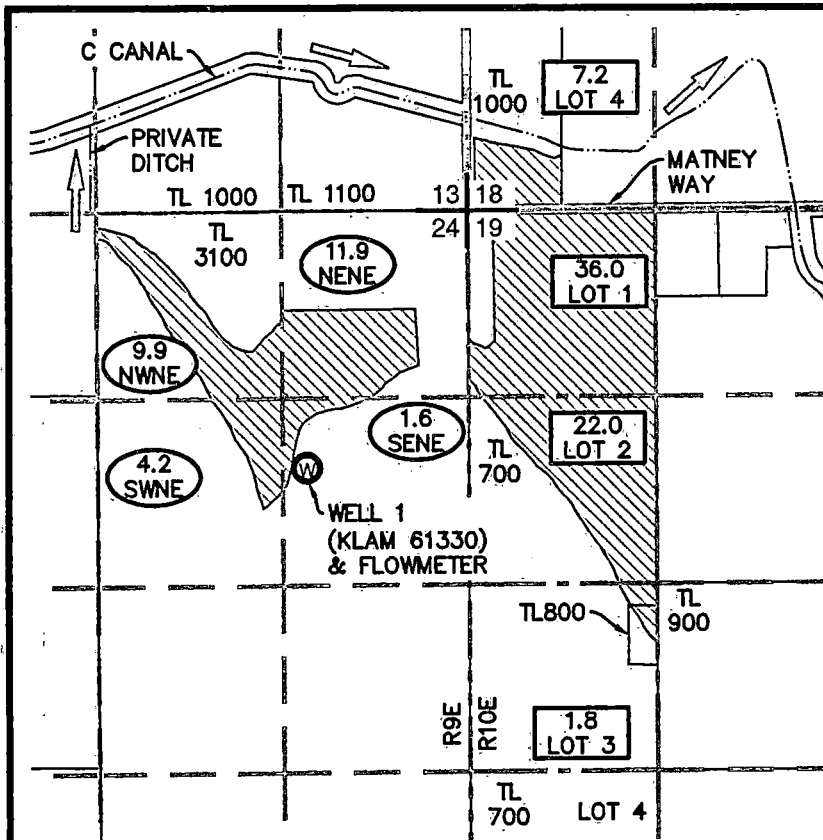
