Re: R-15198 XP Reservoir Limited License Application

To Whom It May Concern:

XP Reservoir has filled to capacity this winter pursuant to Permit No. R-15198. Rogue Family Farms is in the process of filing for a secondary water right for the storage water. To facilitate use of the storage water in the meantime, an application for the limited use of storage water during the 2024 irrigation season is attached.

A copy of the Application, Map and Water Availability Statement were submitted to the Jackson County Watermaster's Office on March 4, 2024. A Land Use Information Form for the proposed use was submitted to the Jackson County Planning Department on March 4, 2024. Copies of the completed Statement and Form will be provided to OWRD upon receipt.

Rogue Family Farms operated XP Reservoir for irrigation during the 2023 irrigation season pursuant to Limited License No. 1950. The operations proposed this year is similar to that approved for last year with the exception of the amount of water available in storage (8.2 ac-ft in 2024 v 3.0 ac-ft in 2023) and the extent of the Place of Use (14 Primary acres in 2024 v 33.6 Primary acres and 4.6 Supplemental acres in 2023). There are 9.4 Primary acres under C- 93873 that are shown on the attached application map. These lands are separate from and not part of the 2024 LL application.

Recording devices that were installed and used last year to meet the conditions outlined in the LL-1950 approval will be used this coming year in a similar fashion. The recording devices and corresponding data recording and submittal protocol have been reviewed and approved by the local Watermaster.

It is our opinion that operation of the license applied for herein can be operated without injury to vested water rights and will not negatively impact the public interest. A few notes included below confirm this position.

In the April 10, 2023 ODFW review of LL-1950, Steven Parrett recommended use under the Permit should comply with applicable water quality laws. Mr. Parrett noted "[T]he proposed water use pumped from an existing permitted reservoir in piping for irrigation using drip tape is unlikely to degrade water quality" and since "LL-1950 is for the use of stored reservoir water, by drip tape irrigation, . . . there should be little or no tailwater return flow to the creek."

A question came up in the OWRD review of the LL-1950 application regarding screening requirements to protect fish species. In his June 2, 2023 email to OWRD, the District Assistant Fish Biologist, Pete Samarin, noted “[T]he Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) has evaluated this site for the presence of Native Migratory Fish (NMF). To our knowledge, there currently are no NMF at or in the vicinity of this location and the location of this reservoir would be considered at or near the upstream end of historical anadromy. Therefore, ODFW is not currently requiring fish screens and will allow a dam to be in place for the impoundment of water.”
