Dear Sir:

I do not find record of a right in the name of James B. Lommen. Certificate recorded at page 1641 was issued to C. E. Eason in evidence of a right to appropriate not to exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second of water from an unnamed spring for domestic use in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 36, Township 3 North, Range 10 West. The priority date for this right is October 5, 1911.

The certificate recorded at page 6760 was issued to School District No. 28, A. D. Lommen, Kasper Huber and Fred Kabbe for the appropriation of water from Kabbe Creek for domestic use in three houses and a school. The priority date of this right is May 11, 1923. The certificate locates the place of use as being the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 26, but the map accompanying the proof locates the houses and school in Sections 25 and 26, Township 3 North, Range 10 West.

If you are referring to a particular right for a specific property, you should send us the legal description of the property concerned and then we can check our records for existence of rights on that property. Our records are kept primarily on a location basis as a right is appurtenant to the land on which the water is used.
