


THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PAUL PIERSON 1432 ELLENSBURG AVENUE #26 GOLD BEACH, OREGON 97444

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of WINCHUCK RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE AT A CAMP TRAILER INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED ONE-HALF ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 48430. The date of priority is MARCH 21, 1984. The right is limited to not more than 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 4, SECTION 7, T 41 S, R 12 W, W.M.; 680 FEET SOUTH AND 1160 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 7.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.





I am writing in response to your recent letter, a copy of which is enclosed. I am sorry that I was not present when your inspector came to examine my property on the Winchuck River. Had I been there, I would have been able to show her where my trailer is located and the diversion point of the water (which. incidentally, is not from the river, but from a very small stream a good ways up the hill). The water system has been installed and in use for a few years now, supplying the trailer with water, as well as irrigation for the front "yard", located below the trailer. To date, the trailer has been used as a summer residence. There is a strong probability, however, of a bridge being installed over the river during the next year, to allow for year round access. It is my intention at that point to begin construction on a more permanent dwelling. I emphatically DO NOT authorize cancellation of my application 65615, permit 48430, and would strongly contest any such cancellation.

I have recently changed my residence, and I apologize for not keeping you apprised of my current address. I would be glad to accompany your inspector on a tour if she would like to come down here again. On October 8, 1988, a representative of this office made an inspection of land in connection with your permit 48430. This permit allowed for the use of up to 0.01 cubic foot per second of water from an unnamed stream for domestic use of one family including lawn and garden. The date for the complete application of water was October 1, 1987.

According to our inspector, after numerous contacts with neighbors, she was able to find your river crossing point. She reports that there are no buildings and no evidence of a diversion point from the creek.

Domestic use normally requires the use of water in a house for household purposes. Since there is no house, this permit is no longer valid and should be cancelled.

Enclosed is a form for your use in authorizing the cancellation of this permit. The cancellation would clear it from our records and avoid the necessity for further notices or correspondence.

We received your letter on June 30 regarding the construction phase for your Permit 48430. This permit describes the appropriation of the waters of an unnamed stream for domestic use for one family including the irrigation of not to exceed one-half acre lawn and garden.

You informed us August 9, 1984 that the construction phase was completed for the permit. You stated in this letter that you have a water system installed and have in fact been using it for domestic purposes, however, it is not complete to your satisfaction. If the system is in and capable of the domestic use and also the hose bibs for the lawn and garden, then although it may not be to your satisfaction, it may be complete as far as we're concerned. If the system will utilize the amount of water and is capable of use for both purposes at this time, then we would consider that as completion of construction. An enhancement to make it easier for you to use would not require an extension of time in so far as the permits concerned.

If on the other hand, the system is such that you are not able to use it for the lawn and garden at the present time, then you should complete that prior to October I of this year.

I am enclosing an extension application for you to fill out should it be necessary for you to do so. Please give us sufficient information to determine whether diligence has been utilized progressing towards completion of the project, so that we may properly assess the ability to grant such an extension. The request will have to be submitted to this office with the satutory fee in the amount of \$100.

This permit presently allows until October 1, 1987 to apply the water to beneficial use. You have informed us domestic use has been made and you have until October 1, 1987 in which to apply the lawn and garden portion of the permit to beneficial use. This may change your impression of whether you need an extension or not. Please let us know if there is any further information that we can relay to you.

Your Application 65615 describing the proposed use of 1/80th of a cubic foot per second of water from an unnamed stream for domestic use for one family including irrigation of a one-half garden, together with the four prints of a map and legal description, has been reviewed. Our Receipt 38010 covering the fees of \$35 you first submitted is enclosed. Our Receipt 38045 covering the additional fees of \$25 was sent to you with our letter of September 1, 1983.

It will be necessary for you to clarify the location of your proposed project and supply additional information before your application can be considered for approval.

The legal description does not describe property including the housesite illustrated on your supporting map but describes a tract of land from the east bank of the Winchuck River to the county road. If your map correctly represents the location of the housesite to be supplied water, it will be necessary for you to submit the proper legal description. The legal description may be copied from your deed, title insurance policy, or sales contract.

The E1/4 Corner of Section 13 is not illustrated on the maps you submitted. Rather than prepare another map, you may wish to merely reference the point of diversion by distances from the NW Corner of Section 7. I have illustrated a manner of doing this on one of your maps in pencil. If you agree, the information in pencil will need to be redone in ink and Item 2 on your application will need to be amended to be in agreement. Domestic use may include the irrigation of a garden providing the garden is noncommercial. Therefore, if you intend a noncommercial garden, this must be clearly stated in Item 5 of the application.
