RE: Application for Limited Water Use License

Dear Mary,

The enclosed application for a Limited Water Use License, and supporting documentation, is submitted on behalf of Jeld-Wen, Inc. (Jeld-Wen). Also enclosed is the \$280 application fee. Jeld-Wen is proposing to use groundwater at a rate not to exceed 224 gpm (0.5 cfs) for industrial use from an existing well at the Jeld-Wen manufacturing site in Klamath Falls.

Jeld-Wen has been operating this well under a limited license (LL-1784) that expires this summer. This application is designed to continue the authorization to operate the well while Jeld-Wen and the Department finalize the mitigation package associated with Jeld-Wen's permanent groundwater permit application (Application G-17983).

We understand that mitigation is required for water use under the enclosed Limited License application and propose using the same mitigation that was approved for LL-1784; Jeld-Wen's Claim KA-107. Claim KA 107 has been leased instream in its entirety (1.0 cfs), and the application for the enclosed Limited License application proposes to continue the use of IL-1550 for mitigation going forward. The final order for IL-1550 is included as an attachment to this Limited License Application. Jeld-Wen anticipates that use of water under the enclosed Limited License application will cease once Application No. G-17983 is approved and a permanent groundwater permit is issued by the Department.

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

NOTE: A completed water availability statement from the local watermaster, Land Use Information Form completed by the local Planning Department, fees and site map meeting the requirements of OAR 690-340-030 must accompany this request. The fee for this request is \$280 for the first point of diversion plus \$30 for each additional point of diversion. Please review the Department's fee schedule to view fees required to request a limited license for Aquifer Storage and Recovery testing purposes or for Artificial Groundwater Recharge testing purposes.

Failure to provide any of the required information will result in return of your application. The license, if granted, will not be issued or replaced by a new license for a period of more than five consecutive years. The license, if granted, will be subordinate to all other authorized uses that rely upon the same source, or water affected by the source, and may be revoked at any time it is determined the use causes injury to any other water right or minimum perennial streamflow.

If water source is well, well logs or adequate information for the Department to determine aquifer, well depth, well seal and open interval, etc. are required. The licensee shall indicate the intended aquifer. If for multiple wells, each map location shall be clearly tired to a well log.

If a limited license is approved, the licensee shall give notice to the Department (Watermaster) at least 15 days in advance of using the water under the Limited License and shall maintain a record of use. The record of use shall include, but need not be limited to, an estimate of the amount of water used, the period of use and the categories of beneficial use to which the water is applied. During the period of the Limited License, the record of use shall be available for review by the Department upon request.

Mapping Requirements (OAR 690-340-0030):

- (1) A request for a limited license shall be submitted on a form provided by the Water Resources Department, and shall be accompanied by the following:
 - a. A site map of reproducible quality, drawn to a standard, even scale of not less than 2 inches = 1 mile, showing:
 - i. The locations of all proposed points of diversion referenced by coordinates or by bearing and distance to the nearest established or projected public land survey corner;
 - ii. The general course of the source for the proposed use, if applicable;
 - iii. Other topographical features such as roads, streams, railroads, etc., which may be helpful in locating the diversion points in the field.



Authority

Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 537.348 establishes the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to lease an existing water right for instream purposes. Senate Bill (SB) 206 (Chapter 445, Oregon Laws 2015) establishes that a determined claim in the Upper Klamath Basin may be leased to instream use. Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Chapter 690, Division 077 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating instream lease applications.

Findings of Fact

- On May 9, 2016, Jeld-Wen Inc. filed an application to lease the entirety of Klamath Water Right Claim KA-107 for instream use. The Department assigned the application number IL-1550.
- 2. The Klamath Water Right Claim to be leased is as follows:

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 3. The lease application includes the information required under OAR 690-077-0076(3). The Department provided notice of the lease application pursuant to OAR 690-077-0077(1). No comments were received.
- 4. The instream use requested by the Lessor requires modification to prevent any injury to other water rights and enlargement. The Lessor requests to protect water instream from June 1 through October 15, a 137 day period. At the requested rate (1.0 CFS) and volume (100.0 AF), water may not be protected instream for the full 137 days without exceeding the 100.0 AF volume limit. However, the instream rate may be reduced to protect water instream for the full 137 day period requested up to 100.0 AF.
- 5. The instream use has been modified from the lease application to prevent injury and enlargement and is as follows:

Upper Klamath Lake, tributary to Klamath River

Instream Point: At the POD (as described in Finding of Fact No. 2)

6. Other conditions to prevent injury and enlargement are:

The instream use established by this lease may, during the requested instream period, provide for maintenance of natural lake levels in Upper Klamath Lake up to 4143.3 feet (elevation).

- 7. The amount and timing of the proposed instream flow is allowable within the limits and use of the original water right claim.
- 8. The protection of flows at the authorized point of diversion is appropriate, considering:

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a. The instream water use begins at the recorded point of diversion;

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b. The location of confluences with other streams downstream of the point of diversion.

- c. There are no known areas of natural loss of streamflow to the river bed downstream from the point of diversion; and
- d. Any return flows resulting from the exercise of the existing water right claim would reenter the river downstream of the point of the instream water right.
- 9. The total monthly quantities of water to be protected under the existing and proposed instream rights at the point will provide for a beneficial purpose.

- 10. The total monthly quantities of water to be protected instream under existing and proposed instream rights at the point do not exceed the estimated average natural lake level.
- 11. If approved, this instream lease is not reasonably expected to significantly affect land use as prescribed by ORS 197.180, OAR Chapter 660, Divisions 30 and 31, and OAR Chapter 690, Division 5.
- 12. Based upon review of the application, information provided by the Department's Watermaster, and other available information, the Department finds that the lease will not result in injury or enlargement. The order approving this instream lease may be modified or revoked under OAR 690-077-0077 if the Department later finds that the lease is causing injury to any existing water right or enlargement of the original right.
- 13. If a water right claim which has been leased is later proposed to be leased again, transferred and/or reviewed under an allocation of conserved water, a new injury review shall be required. For example, instream transfers will be subject to a full and complete review to determine consistency with the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 and Division 077. Approval of this lease does not establish a precedent for approval of any future transactions.
- 14. The Lessor has requested that the lease terminate on December 31, 2020. The lease may commence on the date this final order is signed.
- 15. The Lessor has requested the option of terminating the lease early with written notice to the Department.

Conclusions of Law

The Department concludes that the lease will not result in injury or enlargement, OAR 690-077-0077. The lease conforms to the applicable provisions of OAR 690-077-0015.

Now, therefore it is ORDERED:

- 1. The Lease as described herein is APPROVED.
- 2. During each year of the term of the lease, the former place of use will no longer receive water as part of this water right claim.

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3. The term of the lease will commence upon approval of the instream lease and terminate on December 31, 2020. For multiyear leases, the lessor *shall* have the option of terminating the lease any time each year with written notice to the Department. However, if the termination request is received less than 30-days prior to the instream use period (June 1 through October 15) or after the water rights' original period of allowed use has begun, the Department may issue an order terminating the lease but use of water may not be allowed until the following calendar year, unless the Director determines that enlargement would not occur.
