This Is to Certify, That

OREGON STATE PARKS & RECREATION SECTION

of 300 State Hwy. Bldg., Salem , State of Oregon, 97310 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Clyde Holliday State Wayside Well

a tributary of John Day River irrigation of 5.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. G-4991 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 23, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the well. The well is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 27, T. 13 S., R. 30 E., W. M., 580 feet South and 925 feet West from the NE Corner, Section 27

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited tonne-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.0 acres NW4 NE4 Section 27 T. 13 S., R. 30 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.


