Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

<u>Application History</u>

Permit G-18117 was issued by the Department on November 16, 2018. and modified by Permit Amendment T-7490 on <permit amendment issue date>. The permit specified actual construction of the well to begin by November 16, 2023, completion of construction by and complete application of water to beneficial use by November 16, 2023. The most recent extension authorized completion of construction and complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, . On December 21, 2023, Dale Marwwod submitted an Application for Extension of Time for Permit G-18117. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on March 19, 2024, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to complete construction to October 1, 2028, and the time to fully apply water to beneficial use to October 1, 2028. The protest period closed May 3, 2024, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the findings of fact in the Proposed Final Order dated March 19, 2024.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, any comments received, and information within the file, the permit may be extended subject to the following condition:

LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS

1. Water Use Condition

If no water is applied to beneficial use under the terms and conditions of Permit G-18117 on or before October 1, 2028, this will be the be the last extension of time granted for Permit G-18117 Any future extensions of time request will be denied, unless the permit holder can provide the Department with evidence that beneficial use of the water is shown during this extension period. In addition, all normal extension standards and rules will be evaluated. ORS 539.010(5); OAR 690-315-0040.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.630, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

ORDER

The extension of time for Application G-18507, Permit G-18117, therefore, is approved subject to conditions contained herein. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use within the terms and conditions of the permit is extended from November 16, 2023, to October 1, 2028.
