The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SE¼ SW¼), Section 9, T. 41 S., R. 13 W., W.M. Well 1 located 350 feet South and 70 feet West from the NW corner T. Sharp DLC 41.

HARVE JOEL STRAHM

The Registration Statement was filed under Registration No. GR-2125 in the name of Joe Knutsen, claiming an appropriation of 90 gallons per minute for the irrigation of 10.4 acres, being 5.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, 5.4 in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, Township 41 South, Range 13 West, W. M. for which Certificate of Registration No. GR-3954 was issued. The date construction work was begun is unknown but is claimed to have been completed on August 10, 1952. The use of water is described as being from a sump well 25 to 30 feet deep and 20 feet wide by 30 feet long, located 1800 feet south and 1100 feet east from the West $\frac{1}{4}$ corner, Section 9, being within SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 9, Township 41 South, Range 13 West, W. M.

Harve Joel Strahm of P.O. Box 2216, Harbor, Oregon submitted proof No. 7 claiming a right to the use of the ground waters of Harbor Reservoir under an initiation date of August 10, 1952 for 85 gallons per minute thru a dug well 23 feet deep, 20 feet wide and 30 feet long, located within Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 9, Township 41 South, Range 13 West, W. M. The use claimed is for irrigation of 9.7 acres of lily bulb crops being 2.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 6.9 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the said section. The claimant lists the well rating as 85 gallons per minute.

The Water Resources Department classified 9.7 acres of lily bulbs as irrigated, being 2.8 acres in Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), 1.5 acres in Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), 5.4 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within T. Sharp, D.L.C. 41, Section 9, Township 41 South, Range 13 West, W. M. Water is diverted from a dug sump well with a Cornell 2 X 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch centrifugal pump powered by a 5 horsepower electric motor. The sump well is covered with a concrete dome and has a drain installed 7 feet below land surface to prevent winter overflow of the sump. The summer surface water level of the sump is said to be 10 feet below land surface. The well is located 350 feet south and 70 feet west from the NW corner T. Sharp D.L.C. 41, being within Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 9, Township 41 South, Range 13 West, W. M. Water is pumped through 640 feet of 2 inch diameter aluminum pipe, 520 feet of 3 inch diameter aluminum pipe, and 16 Rainbird No. 30 and No. 40 sprinklers with 5/32 X 3/32 inch nozzles. All 14 sprinklers are operated at one time. The ground elevation at the well site is 77.27 feet.

It appears that this claimed right should be limited to a rate of diversion of not to exceed 0.121 cubic foot per second (54 gallons per minute) of ground water for irrigation of 9.7 acres with a date of priority of August 10, 1952. Claimant's rights are more particularly set out and described in the tabulation of water rights under finding 36 herein.

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CECIL WATT

The Registration Statement was filed under Registration No. GR-542 in the name of Cecil Watt claiming an appropriation of 100 gallons per minute for the irrigation of 23.0 acres, being 6.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10, 14.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, 3.0 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16, Township 41 South, Range 13 West, W. M. for which Certificate of Registration No. GR-517 was issued. Construction work is claimed to have begun in May, 1948. The use of water is described as being from a drilled well 44 feet deep, 12 inches in diameter, located 717 feet south and 405 feet east from the NW corner, Section 15, being within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, Township 41 South, Range 13 West, W. M. The casing is described in the Registration Statement as being perforated from 25 feet to 44 feet.

Cecil Watt of 707 Wedgewood Lane, Route 1, Brookings, Oregon, submitted proof No. 8 claiming a right to the use of the ground waters of Harbor Reservoir under an initiation date of May, 1948 for 2 to 3 inches every 10 to 12 days, applied rate one-half inch per hour through a 12 inch diameter drilled well, 44 feet deep located within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, Township 41 South, Range 13 West, W. M. The use claimed is for irrigation of 11.8 acres of lily bulb crops being 3.6 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 10 and 8.2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15. The claimant lists the pump rating as 100 gallons per minute.

The Water Resources Department classified 11.8 acres of lily bulbs as irrigated, being 1.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within T. Sharp D.L.C. 41, 1.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within E. O'Laughlin D.L.C. 42, Section 10, 6.3 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within E. O'Laughlin D.L.C. 42, 1.9 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ as projected within R. Johnson D.L.C. 43, Section 15, Township 41 South, Range 13 West, W. M. Water is diverted from a well with a Peerless 4 inch discharge turbine pump powered by a 5 horse-power electric motor. 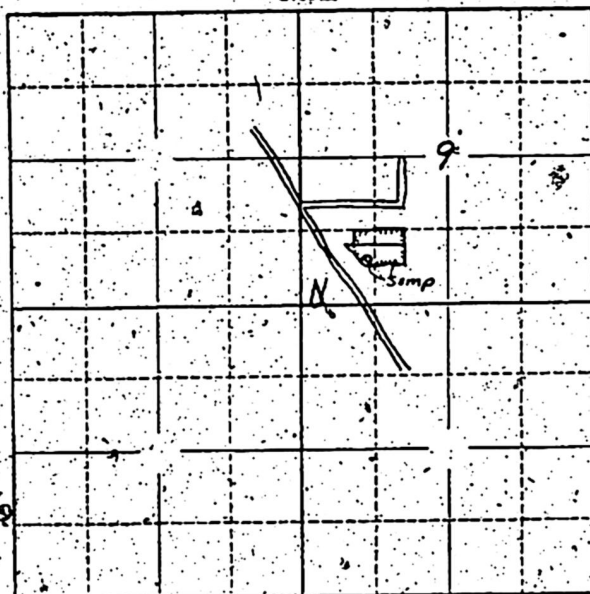

Enclosed is the water rights information you requested in your letter dated April 8, 1988. Also enclosed is Receipt 54785 in the amount of \$5.50 acknowledging your payment of copying fees.

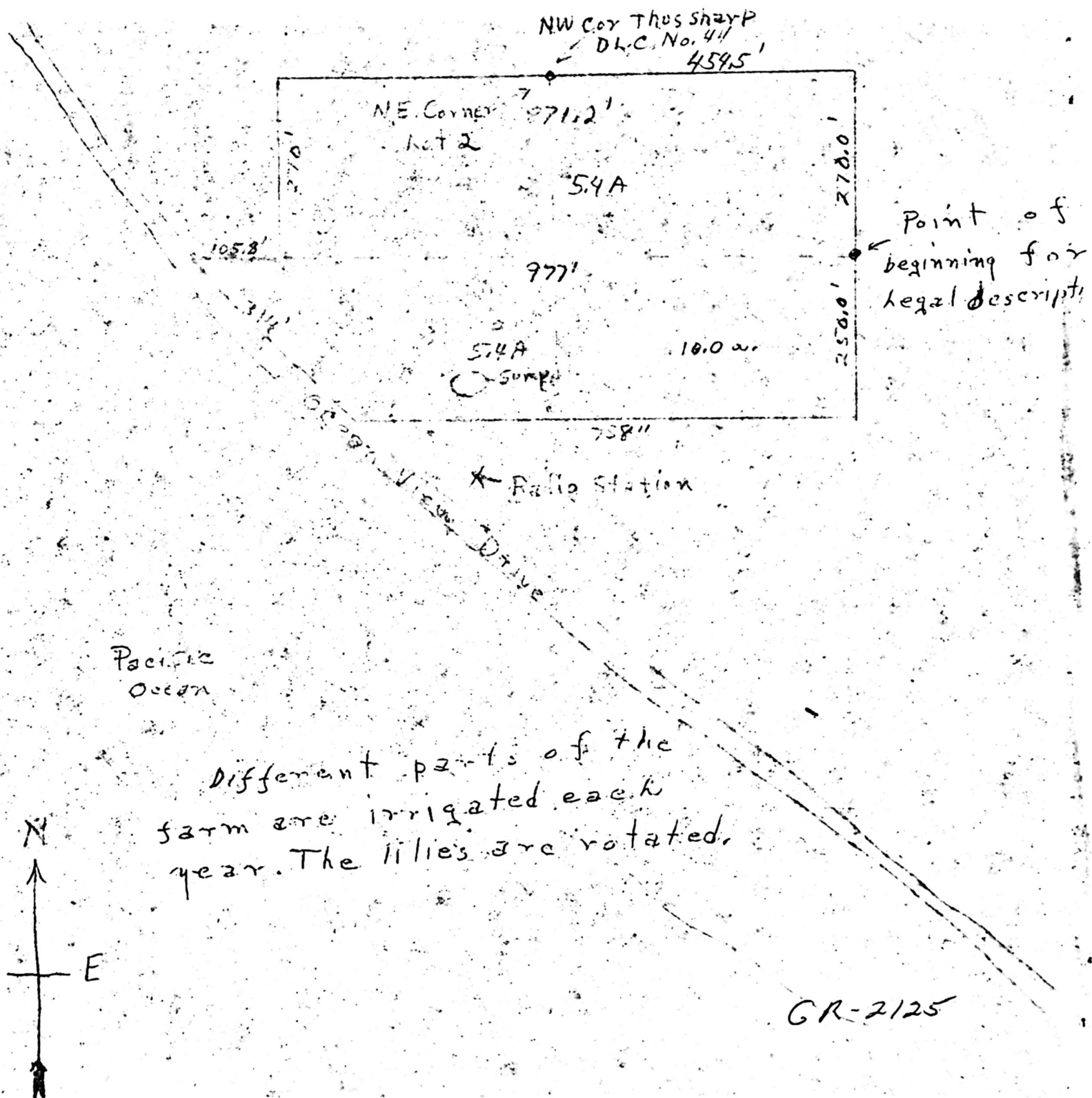

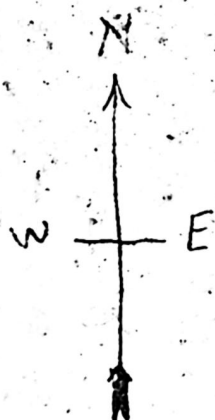
