Dear Ms. Bjork:

Please find the enclosed Application for Limited Water Use License on behalf of NewSun Cascade Development Services LLC, related application materials, and required processing fee.

The OWRD local Watermaster statement provided by Jeremy Giffin identifies the need for the use to be offset. The owner of TL 1000 (Randy Kruse/Kruse Ranch, LLC), is the holder of a portion of Oregon Water Right Certificate 80626 (specifically a 121.008 acre portion of Irrigation Use –the rate being 1.51 cfs, the duty being 363.02 AF). The 121.008 portion of C- 80626 will not be irrigated during the life of the Limited License in order to provide an offset for the proposed use. The 121.008 acre portion of C-80626 is currently under review for a proposed Permanent Transfer to a new place of use and point of appropriation via T-14353. If a final order is issued approving the transfer prior to the end of the limited license, New Sun Energy, LLC and Kruse Ranch, LLC will not pump at the new point of appropriation until the Limited License is completed or cancelled.

NOTE: A completed water availability statement from the local watermaster, Land Use Information Form completed by the local Planning Department, fees and site map meeting the requirements of OAR 690-340-030 must accompany this request. The fee for this request is \$280 for the first point of diversion plus \$30 for each additional point of diversion. Please review the Department's fee schedule to view fees required to request a limited license for Aquifer Storage and Recovery testing purposes or for Artificial Groundwater Recharge testing purposes.

Failure to provide any of the required information will result in return of your application. The license, if granted, will not be issued or replaced by a new license for a period of more than five consecutive years. The license, if granted, will be subordinate to all other authorized uses that rely upon the same source, or water affected by the source, and may be revoked at any time it is determined the use causes injury to any other water right or minimum perennial streamflow.

If water source is well, well logs or adequate information for the Department to determine aquifer, well depth, well seal and open interval, etc. are required. The licensee shall indicate the intended aquifer. If for multiple wells, each map location shall be clearly tied to a well log.

If a limited license is approved, the licensee shall give notice to the Department (Watermaster) at least 15 days in advance of using the water under the Limited License and shall maintain a record of use. During the period of the Limited License, the record of use shall be available for review by the Department upon request.
