This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from three unnamed springs, being 0.03 cfs from each of No. 1 and No. 2 and 0.04 cfs from No. 3

The use to which this water is to be applied is Public park purposes

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to - - - of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The priority date of this permit is June 9, 1958

Actual construction work shall begin on or before September 17, 1959 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1960...

Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1961.

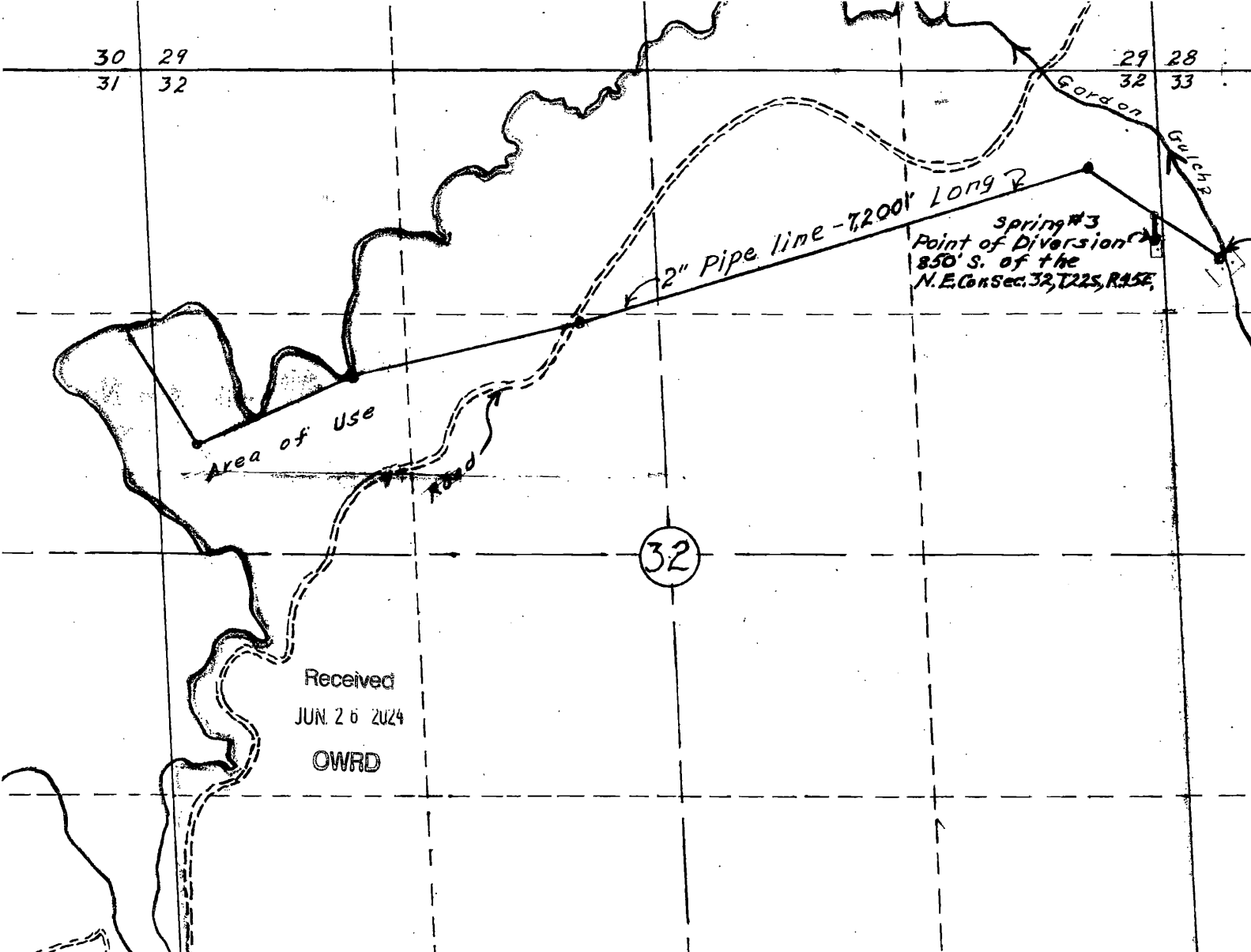

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OREGON STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION

of Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of three unnamed springs

a tributary of Owyhee Reservoir for the purpose of public park purposes

under Permit No. 25571 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 9, 1958;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second, being 0.03 c.f.s. from No. 1 and No. 2 and 0.04 c.f.s. from No. 3,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the No. 3 - NE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 32; No. 1 and No. 2 - NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 33; T. 22 S., R. 45 E., W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
